GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER

Most of the demands that were earlier raised during B₂V₁ and B₂V₂ were not addressed due to lack of funds and infrastructure.

Urgent Public Demands that needs to be addressed are as under:-

- ① Requirement of Primary Health Centre in the Panchayat. The existing subcentre is working in very small private building and does not have enough space to operate properly.
- ② In GHSS Sallan 6 old rooms and hall are in damaged condition and there is constant water leakage in the building during rains and is unsafe for the students. There is need for urgent repairs in the school building as it was constructed in 1964 by the funds provided by local people. A new examinations Hall and 9 new rooms are required on priority basis for the smooth & safe functioning of the school.
- ③ Synthetic valley ball court work that was tendered by the concerned Department is still incomplete. The work was stopped two years ago needs to be completed on priority.
- ④ Separate Panchayat Ghar building is required.
- ⑤ Bank branch / ATM is required on priority.
- ⑥ No Khidmat centre is available in the panchayat.
- ⑦ Animal Husbandary dispensary is urgently needed in GP.
- ⑧ Tube well is required in Sallan.
- ⑨ A motor to lift water from well in Pacea Kotra near Mandi.
- ⑩ OHT at Kasba village is required.
- ⑪ Construction of Block Top road from Billaawa to Primary School is required.
