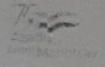

Digitalisation of land done but no land passbook issued.

5. Fisheries:- Benefits of Trout culture scheme not yet shared with the village.

6. Education Department:-

Walls of Govt Primary school craked and building can collapse any time thus keeping the life of innocent children at high risk.

Shortage of staff in all schools.

Demand of computer classes put forward by locals and teachers also.

7. PHE Department:-

Water supply not yet delivered to people living at the area of petha Khanan.

Dirty and unfiltered water supplied to the locals. (People angry with the department) No development done since past B2V 3 .

8. R&B Department:-

Road connectivity to Phera Kanan not constructed due to non availability of NOC from Forest department.

9. Health Department:-

Subcenter located in private building without any doctor.

People demand a fully functional health center with a Doctor in a Govt. Building.

Employees don't cooperative with the Medical officer of Ayush Health and wellness center located in a well maintained Govt Building, it is demanded to shift the center with immunisation in the Ayush health wellness center.

10. Irrigation and flood control Department.

Proper bund not created at upper areas of Khanan thus leading to recurrent flash floods and damage to the local houses and Govt building also.

11. Social welfare department.

Three deserving specially abled person deprived of Vehicles under scheme.

12. Note MGNREGA Supporting staff is without salary from april 2022 to till date they are suffering ~~there~~^{their} problem may be looked into for sympathetic grounds they are working day and night.
