Annexure - CGeneral Assessment of the visiting officer

I. The most pressing complaint/demand is that the panchayat needs a Health Centre.

III. The overall assessment is that on the whole, the panchayat is on track with regard to developmental activities and human development. However, lack of basic infrastructural facilities like roads, electricity supply, water supply, and the almost broken bridge near the school at Razbagh etc, needs to be looked into/planned and executed at the earliest. The list of demands for works projected by the people in the Gram Sabha today on Day 2 of B.V.U Programme has been duly noted and discussed and the VDP was prepared on the basis of the same. Also the panchayat, as stated above, needs a health centre and the same needs to be sanctioned. Besides, the Middle School Building at Razbagh doesn't have proper drainage which weakens the foundation of the building during rains particularly. This issue needs to be looked into. Also the school premises has a ^{quite small} building which needs to be demolished at the earliest. The M.S. needs to be upgraded to a High School. Women employment seems to be the need of the hour. They are apparently participating in the development process.
