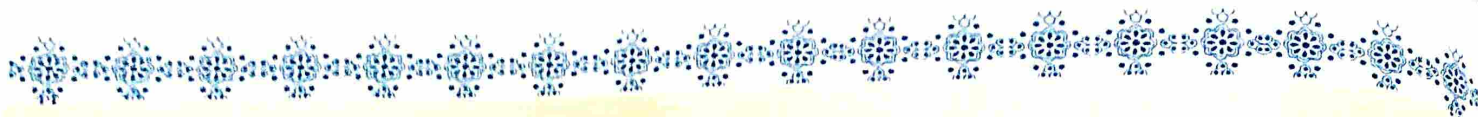

youth groups met the visiting team and requested to visiting officers that a playground may kindly be constructed as most of the youth are involved in drugs due to non-availability of playground.

The team highly recommends the construction of playground at the said site, which has been encroached by some of the miscreants.

4. The team headed by the visiting officer along with Sarpanch Chelga visited Indoor stadium which had been ~~was~~ constructed in 2014-15 but not completed yet.

The team observed ~~that~~ ~~low~~ and recommends the completion of the said Indoor stadium at an earliest.

5. The team have a detailed look of the inner links of the village and found that all the links need to be upgraded with black top.

6. The team visited different schools of the village and found that the Academic side of all the institutions is satisfactory. During the

NOTES

inspection of P/S Dawood Colony the team found the kitchen shed of the school is damaged which needs to be repaired. One of the building of GUPS Maratgam has been kept incomplete which is simply a threat for the innocent children and ^{also} mars the beauty of the institution. The school buildings of UPS Maratgam are old and are timed out so

new buildings need to be sanctioned for the said institution. Also the lawn of the said school is somewhat irregular so the lawn needs to be levelled which will benefit the children in sports activities.

7. The village is settled on two streams which creates threat to the inhabitants of the village in the rainy season as both of the streams are filled with polythene and other garbage creating floods. So the team recommends desilting of both the streams and the protection fund on both the sides of the streams so that the village is protected from the threat of floods in future.

8. The team observed a clean watered spring, the water of which goes waste. The team recommends that a Scheme may be launched for the preservation and the proper usage of this natural resource which will benefit the inhabitants of Maratgam / Kargama / Gundkabroo / Kabbu and Gulwara so far as the drinking water is concerned.

The team of B2V4 visited Dilmarq Handwara, the road of much importance connecting at least 4 villages and found at least 300 fts encroached by the nearby land owners which has highly effected the economic condition of the people of the entire area. So, the road ~~is~~ needs to be cleared from encroachment.
2. Then the team visited one of the most important site i.e the road connecting Maratgam with Langate. The team was strongly stressed by the inhabitants and ex-security persons for such an important road which has been kept half way and the remaining work has been left ^{as such} which has highly hampered the economic condition of the people of both Maratgam and Langate. So the road needs to be constructed at top most priority as only one kilometer of the said road is pending due to unknown reasons.
3. Since the village is having 63 kanals of Kaccharayi land comprising of vast area. so it was emphasised to the team that a playground be constructed at the said site. The people especially the teams of different
