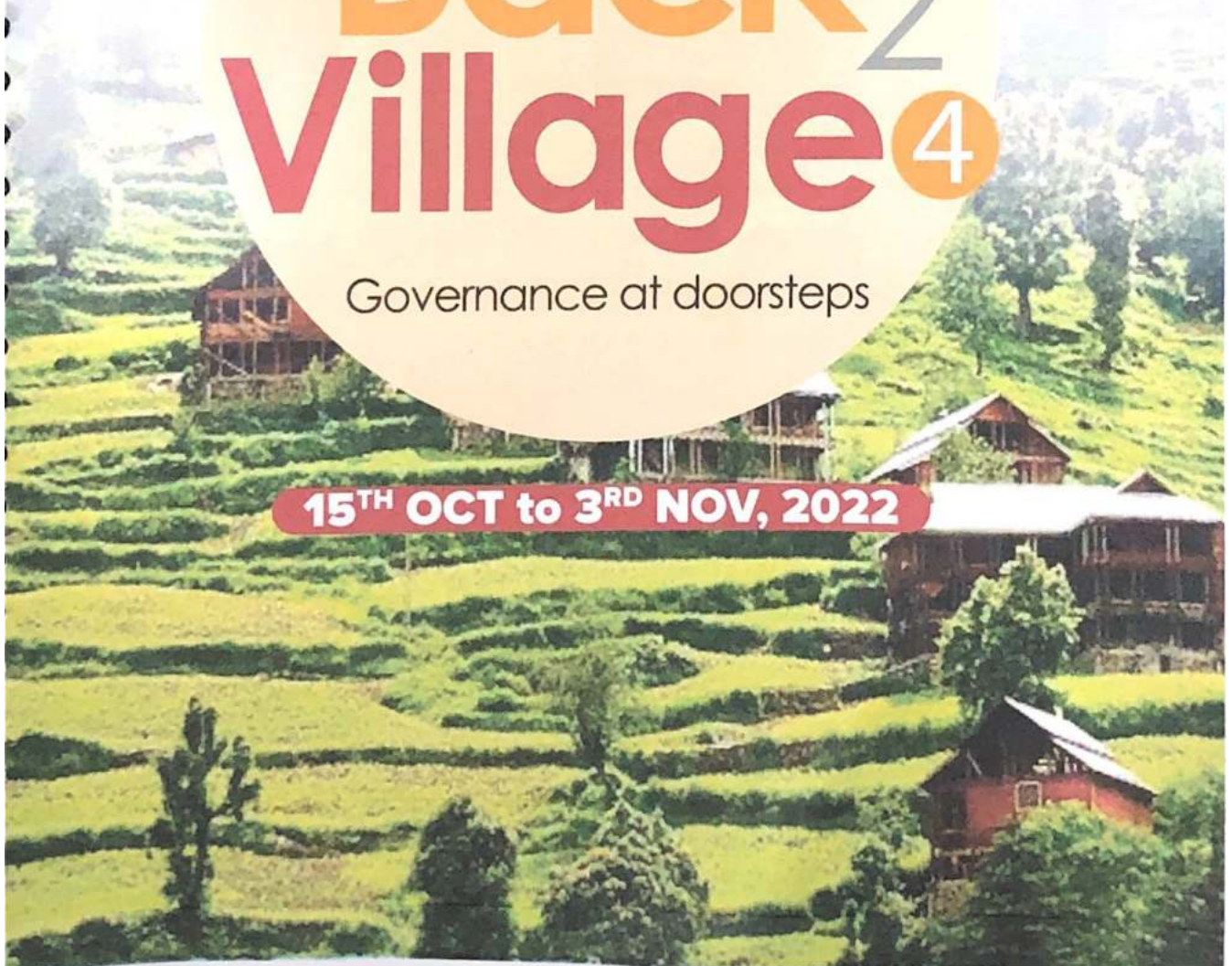

### Major complaint

No action has been taken on demand raised by general public during Back to village 1, 2 and 3 with regard to road connectivity upgradation from Lehnu bridge to Dhandugnoo houn. This is the only road which connect the panchayat Dhandugnoo to main road, which is the prime need of the villagers but no step have been taken in this regard by the department till date.

There is no supply of water till date in the panchayat and the PHE department has not taken any positive steps in this regard till this time. The villagers showed ~~anger~~ because of the non fulfillment of the above mention basic demands.

### Major/Urgent Public Demand

1. The condition of the road from Lehnu bridge to Dhandugnoo - seri is in bad condition and requires immediate upgradation.
2. The infrastructure of the Govt. Higher sec. school, Dhandugnoo needs to be improvised on the demand of general public and the stakeholders (students). Further there are 11 sanitation post of the school in the school but only five post are filled. It is demanded by the stakeholders that vacant post need to be filled at the earliest for the students benefits.
3. Public demanded that the veterinary hospital should be constituted and good staff and doctors to be available as there dependence on the dairy product provided by the livestock. They requested the life of the livestock with no illness as very important.
