GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unblased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
- He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
