



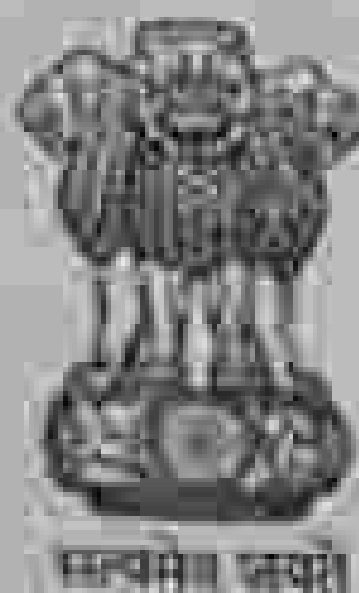

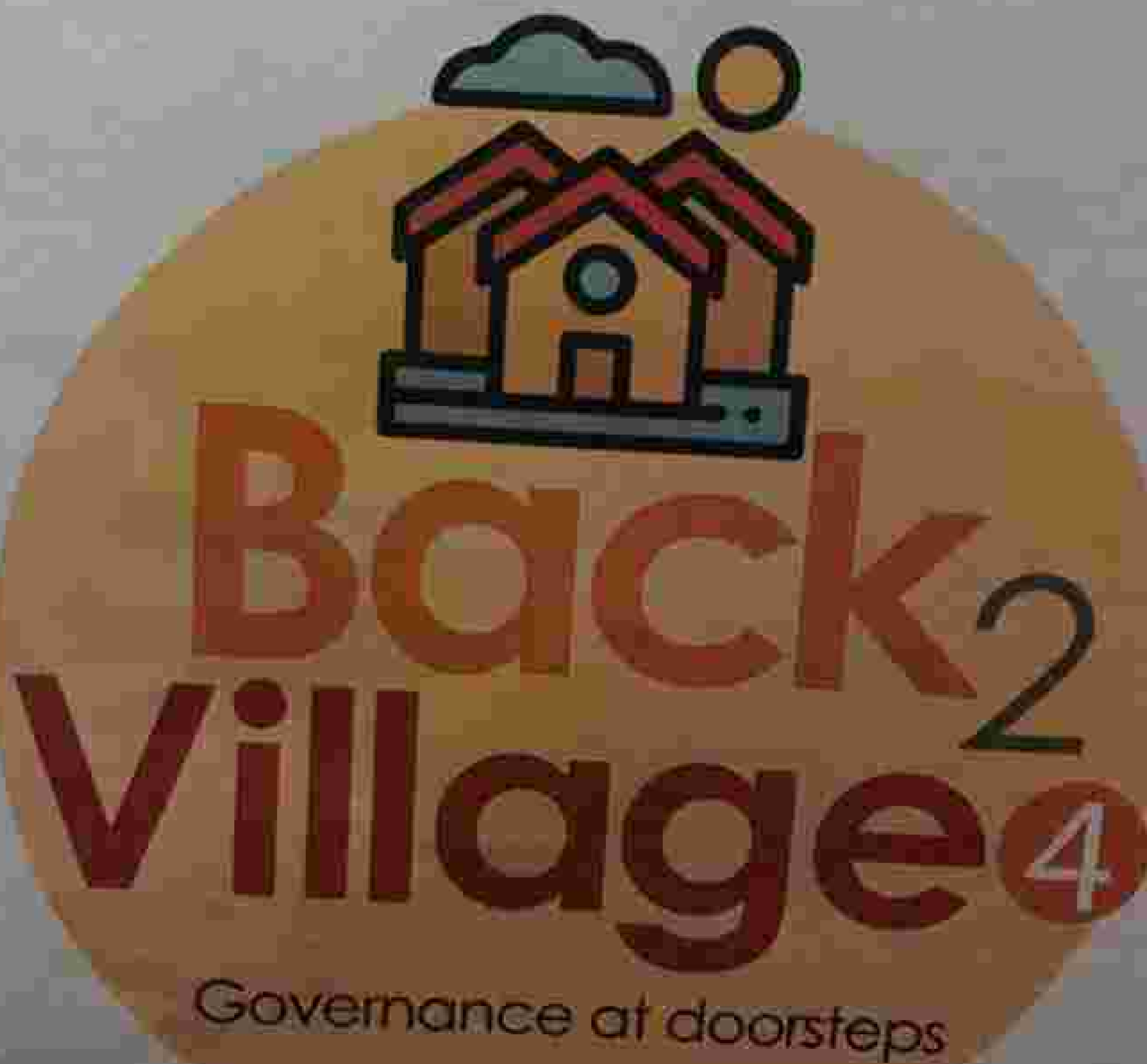
1. Energizing all 4291 panchayats of the UT

Other than this, spreading and evaluating awareness among masses about all online portals and prompt services offered by the government and promoting digital literacy and inclusion among the villagers to take benefit of government services and deliverables efficiently would be significant part of this Jan Abhiyan.

The programme methodology covers major visits by various bureaucrats to languishing projects and leading institutions in the panchayat in order to assess the ground situation and submit a comprehensive report regarding the success of various schemes including a holistic view while celebrating involvement of all stakeholders in the policy making. In Kupwara district, 33

prominent officers will be visiting different panchayats. Worthy Deputy Commissioner has expressed his desire to specify exact locations of the programme in such a way that a diversified perspective can be collected. As this is a joint effort and an important outreach initiative to tailor the schemes according to ground realities and improve overall efficiency of service delivery and hence ensure good governance, it is outrightly inevitable that all supporting staff has to ensure that all necessary interactions are facilitated in a way which ensures another massive response along with achievement of all objectives envisaged by visiting officers.

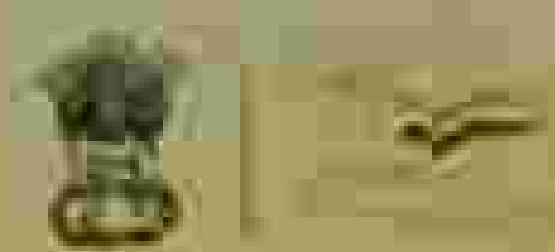

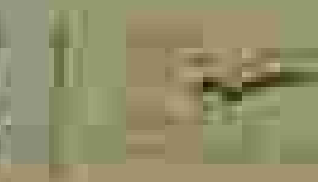

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
2. He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
6. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.
7. Focus of visit are youth, skills, self-employment, nasha mukt, bhrashtrachar mukt, Rozgar yukt J&K, besides to carry forward the activities during Jan Abhiyan and saturate them.

It has been found that the general public were less interested in this programme this year as compared to previous years. And because of that, very less participation of public was found. However people who participated in this programme this year expressed their faith in such Govt. led programmes with the belief that such programmes are implemented in letter and spirit.

Furthermore complaints were put forward by the general public regarding the non-fulfillment of works mentioned in earlier Back to villages thesis. People in this panchayat complained about the poor connectivity of roads and

NOTES

It was seen that most of the link roads are not macadamised at all & should be handed over to PMS.

2. People also complained about the lack of basic health facilities, as the Health Centre available in the Panchayat is not catering the needs of such a huge population. The general public put forth the demand for ~~the~~ 24/7 availability of Doctors and Ambulance.

3. Furthermore they expressed their displeasure regarding the non-availability Veterinary Centre, of which there is a dire need as people complained of huge loss to their livestock because of non-availability of medical facilities for their livestock.

4. Complaint was also received with regard to lack of staff ~~into~~ and other facilities in both primary & High School. The School authorities want the levelling of the School Campus.

5. Urgent need of a Solar Plant and people demand solar lights for every household.

6. Need for (02) Two fair price shops.

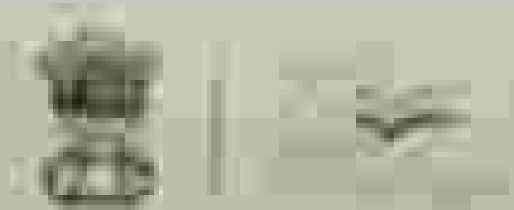

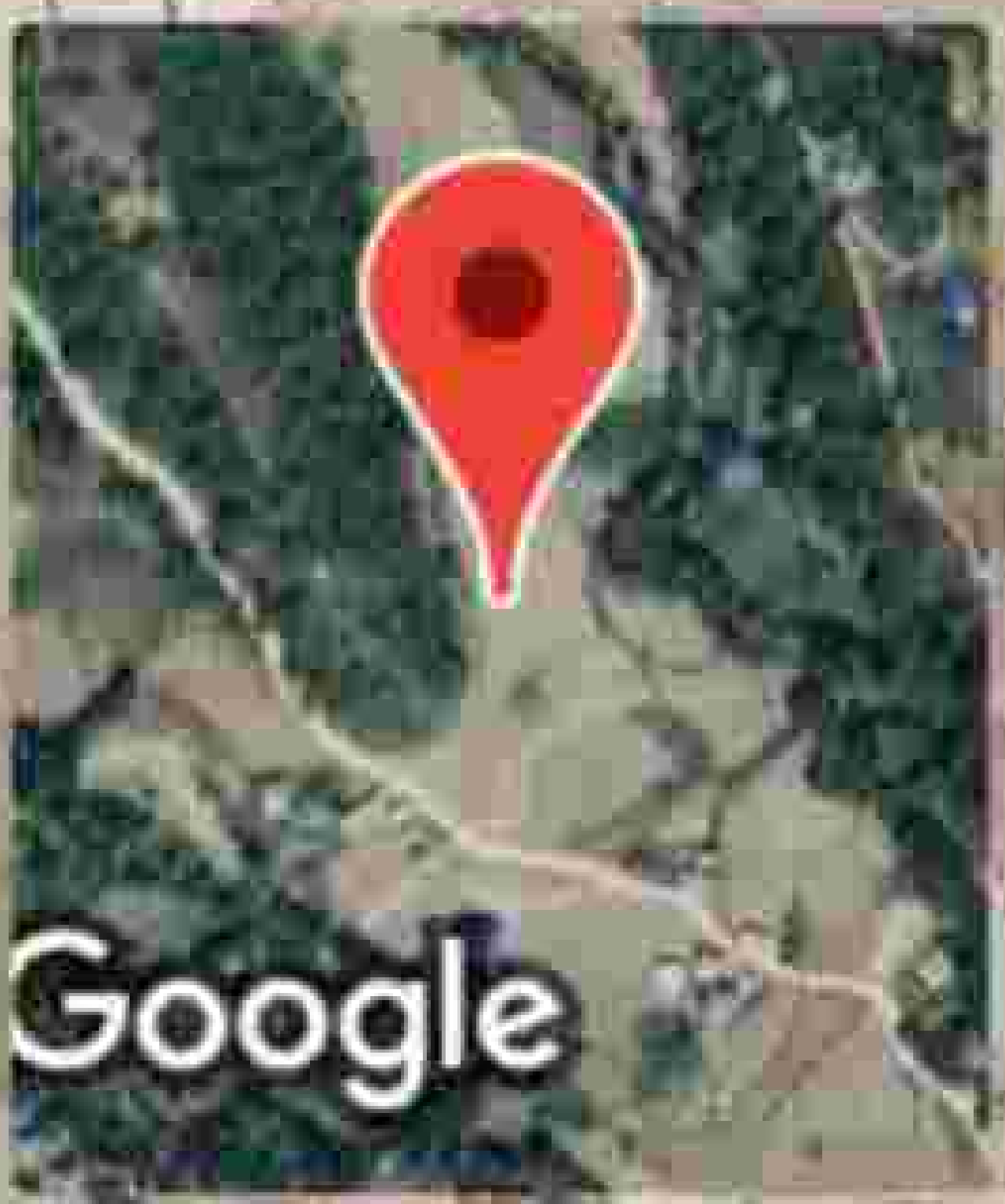
