- Revenue: Patwarikhana is established near GP bhavan, Information about timings is exhibited. Inheritance, mutations are regularly done. Tensildar khansab introduced Apki Zameen Apki Nigroni programme & suggested to verify their revenue record on the App. 03 Land passbooks distributed among farmers during B₂V₄.
- Agriculture and Allied Sectors:
- Out of 394 PM Kisan beneficiaries revenue record of 106 uplod whereas 195 Cases sent for reverification to revenue authorities.

GENERAL ASSESMENT OF VISITING OFFICER

I. Any major Complaint brought to the notice of the visiting officer:
Major Complaint is against School Education Department. There are 03 govt. Schools in GP. HS Raithan, GMS Raithan & PS CK Raithan. Major Complaint is about HS Raithan, the institution is running headless for last couple of years. One person has occupied the post but being a patient of a life threatening disease, the said HM is on long leave. Furthermore the institution has dearth of mathematics teacher & Craft teacher.
GMS Raithan: Recently constructed fencing wall is unsafe because the material used especially cement is sub-standard.

II. Major / Urgent Public Demands that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:

Electricity, Transformers, Replacement of Water pipes, Upgradation of high school, Upgradation of Sub-health Centers, Creation of OYICDS Centers and arrangements for proper Sanitation/DWF were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far.

III. Overall Assessment of the Visit & Suggestions:

The GP is situated on a health resort route but its first view is too ugly to believe. It looks like a big garbage dump.

Though GP members & officials are actively working for improvement in cleanliness of the village, but lack of environmental awareness among masses is the basic problem in this regard.

Proper Sanitation and identification of proper dumping site is need of the hour. Besides awareness programmes should be organised in the village.

One JAO quarter of agriculture department and 04 govt. buildings are under utilized & empty in a dilapidated position. Arrangements could be made to make proper use of the above said buildings for accomodating animal husbandary unit, Public library & Senior Citizen recreational activities.
