Assessment of the visit

The programme was conducted in a very good & conducive atmosphere. The public representation of govt. is very social & civilized & cooperative and performant. During the visit it has been observed that:-

Gen [1]

The front line workers of all the field dep'ts remain in touch with Gen public/RL and try their level best for effective delivery.

Education [2]

There is a Hr. Sec. school having classes from 1st to 12th with total enrollment of 354 students & 20 other school in the govt. There is acute shortage of teaching staff which needs to be filled as per the sanctioned strength. The Phy. School at B. Tut. Dhadar has been closed which needs to be re-considered for opening in the interest of children who otherwise have to traverse/climb up & down at distance of about 1.5 to 2 km through the forest to reach the Hr. Sec. School. Very hectic.

Medical [3]

There is a Med. Aid Centre in the G.P. with one MNPM posted at present functioning in a rented accommodation. Given out the proper infra structure this facility needs to be upgraded with staff and infrastructure.

Animal Husbandry

[4]

During the visit of G.P. some cattle were found ill, and were diagnosed suffering with the Lingey disease by the Sr. vet. Pharmacist Mr. Kesar Singh.

Later on in the Gram Sabha he gave the detailed awareness about the disease to the public and ask them to get their live stock vaccinated. The required vaccine is available with dep't. It was decided to start the vaccination process after the conclusion of B2V programme in a place

⑤ Pub. Works

With regard to the preparation of drinking water supply scheme under JFM for the year 2021-22, the Rabiants / PRA members claimed that the proposal is not feasible as the source of water tapped is insufficient. The further claimed that their suggestions have been ignored by the deptt. regarding the matter. The same needs to be taken up with the Pub. Works Deptt. for its redressal.

⑥ Social Welfare Deptt

A survey the visit of Anganwadi Centres, it has observed that the complete entitlement is not being supplied / provided to the Centres.

The workers & helpers claimed that their pay dues are pending since March 2022. Vacant post of workers at Arvi Tute Shadan may please be filled up.
