During the B.V. two day visit to panch. Halpakhalpore, Block Wairao, Dist. Baramulla, the following points were noticed:


- ① Roads are prepared some are macadamized, few inner links are tilled and few are untilled.

- ⑧ Land for playground to be identified by concerned Patwari


