NOTES

Major Complaints/ Demands

1. One hamlet in the PH and the houses / ~~of~~ Schools / PPTG situated at upper reaches of the Halga do not have the proper water facility. The complaint has earlier been flagged but not addressed till date. The residents demand that the water for these areas be lifted from Mawar Nalla & be stored at water tank that is required to be constructed. This work may be taken up at the earliest.

(2) Rationalisation of electricity is required to be done in the Halga. The Halga has adequate availability of sub stations, however, redistribution is required. The work has been approved ⁱⁿ Gram Sabha & kept in GPDP.

(3) Panchayat Ghar constructed in 2014 is not secured as the building is without chowkidar and proper fencing. The fencing ^(compound walling) & renovation of the Panchayat Ghar is required to be undertaken urgently.

(4) One building completed upto slab level some 08 years ago has remained languishing and not completed. The building was supposed to be handed over to Education Deptt to be used for school. The same building is being misused by the miscreants. The matter is required to be ensured into a work order. The building is needed to be completed ~~at the~~ on urgent basis.
