



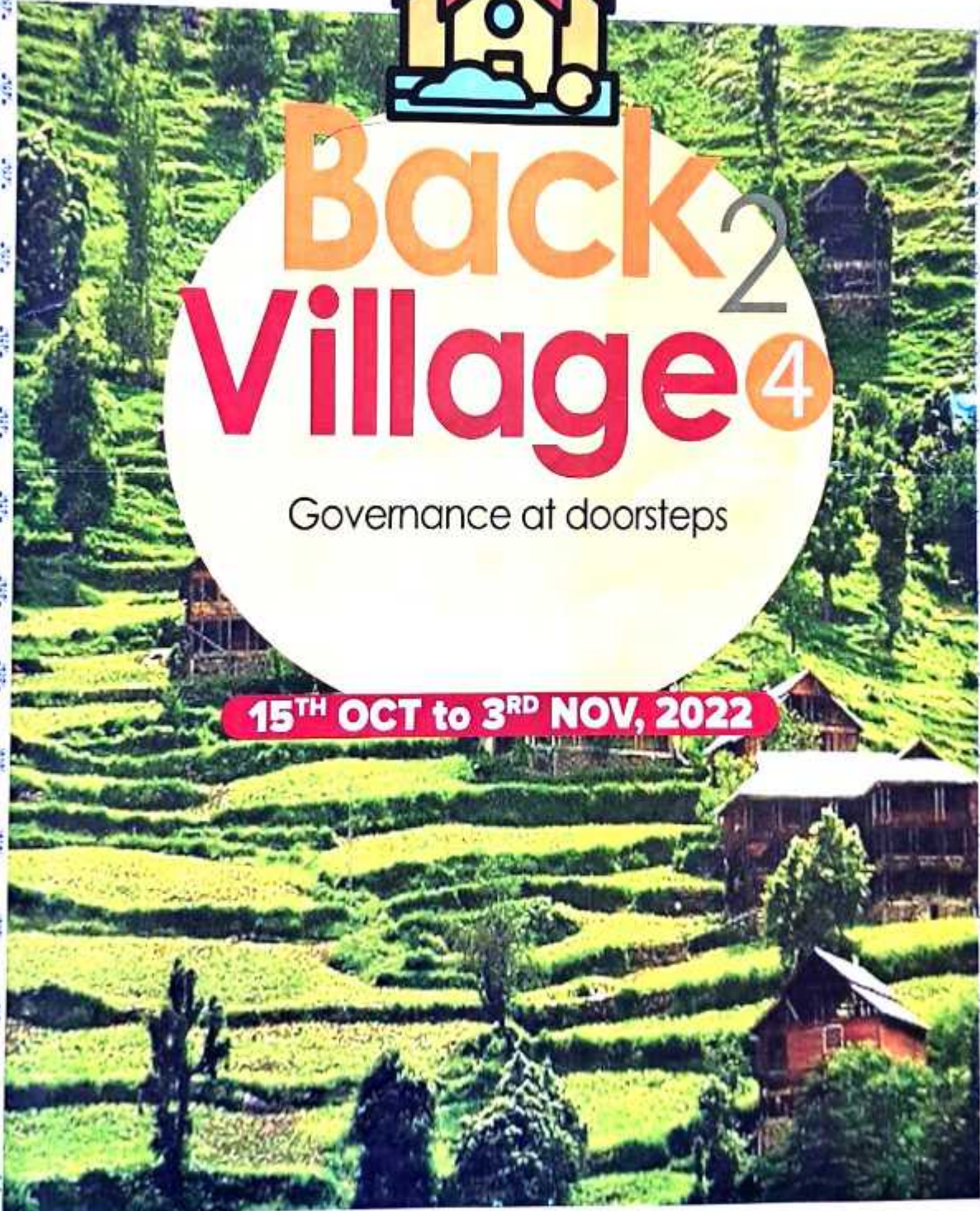

NOTES

On the one hand higher ups insist to prioritize youth but on the ground level, lack of awareness about various Centrally Sponsored Schemes, employment generation schemes is taking a heavy toll. Similarly lack of funds for youth, like cultural activity related funds is making it impossible for the Rels to conduct cultural events/festivals.

Fortunately, few specially abled individuals like Bashir Ali Wani have been demanding scotches so as to run his day to day activities.

Despite availability of land for Playground and public park, the concerned revenue authorities have failed to mark out the land for that purpose.

Mr. Ali Mohammad Lone has donated his owned land measuring 10 marlas for Panchayat Bhavan in the year 2000. However, no compensation/appointment has been provided to his son, Mr. Bashir Ahmad Lone.

NOTES

All important issues of the G.P. and the whole area comprising Waresen, Mazuial, Reshigund A, Reshigund B, Dardsun & Singduna, a total of 5 panchayats are lack of proper drinking water supply and macdamization of link roads. These five burning issues have already been raised in the previous sessions of 'Back to Village' programmes but no action has yet been taken by the District Administration.

On account of this, the whole population has been running from pillar to post but to no avail till date.

Therefore, I request the District Administration to initiate the redressal of the grievances of the local population.

Furthermore, the G.P. needs separate revenue village status and a Patwar Khana so as to mitigate the problems of the villagers. The all-important P.R.s are demanding substantial increase in their remuneration.
