General Assessment

As the GP boycotted the B₂ V₄ Programme. In spite of boycott, I and with front line workers visited different wards and spots where the development works have done by the different Deptts. under different schemes. During the visit meeting with some peoples and beneficiaries.

The major complaints received are as under.

- I a) That all the farmers are not getting the benefits of P.M. Kissan Nidhi Yojna. Only 78 beneficiaries availing the benefits out of 351 eligible beneficiaries.
- b) Some peoples complained that they have no information about B₂ V₄ programme.
- c) Some raised the issue of non-payment of 2nd installment of PMAY.

II The major Demands that have not been addressed,

- a) construction of link road from Pasgal to Morchapur.
- b) construction of link road from main road to Shombari Ghat at Pasgal.
- c) Repair of L/D from the H/O Bhadhus Lal to Joginder Paul at Morchapur ₹ 100000.
- d) There is need of Community Hall at Mata Mandla Morcha Pur.

III. Overall Assessment of the visit.

Panchayat Pasgal mostly have 80% farmers and rest are labourers/business. Peoples are availing the full benefits of most of UT/Central schemes.

34 SHG's are working in the G.P. one water purifier plant is also working. Almost all the lanes in the G.P. are tiled except one or two needs repair.
