Major Complaint:

1/ The school building of Eirkh U/S Doabgah is totally unsafe for children. The life of children is at stake. Immediate action needs to be taken for the safety of children.

2/ The hospital has yet not been shifted to new building. It has created chaos among the people of the village. Moreover, the doctors should be posted in the hospital.

II Major urgent Public Demands but have not been addressed so far.

1/ Desilting of Nalla Khori has yet not been done and has become dumping site and is polluting the drinking water and becoming agent of spreading of diseases. Although this was the peculiar demand of the public made in Back to village II + III.

III Assessment of the visit/public demands/suggestions.

1/ Generator needs to be installed at filter/irrigation scheme (I.H.E.) so that uninterrupted supply of water (drinking) is possible in the area as major demand of public.

2/ Electric Transformer available in the village at the filtration plant site needs to be handed over to the concerned PHE Department for utilisation.

3/ one bridge to be constructed between Doabgah and Rigbal village so that children & adults are facilitated.

4/ one main bridge between Doabgah + Darbari needs to be constructed on priority.

5/ Modernization/Repairment of route from Alsya to Doabgah be completed and taken into consideration.

6/ Paving of liner roads of whole village of Doabgah

- 3/ Protection bond at Mallah at the latch of house of Gh. Nabi Saji of Khazir Mohammad Saji which otherwise shall damage the house.
 - 8/ Lift Irrigation facility for the orchards of Mohd Rangan at Gh. Mohd. Hanif Doojati A. & provided for facilitation.
 - 7/ Land for the construction of residential houses for landless people may be provided so that they could avail the opportunity for dwelling place of their own and can avoid the housing subsistence from government. These landless people are very poor economically down-trodden.
 - 10/ Sericulture that may be induced on the Kachharai of the village that would infuse the employment generation in the village.
 - 4/ Public demanded that one Surgeon of Animal Husbandary be posted in the village.
 - 6/ 4.7 Kms (50 ms) should be made available for Khon Mohalla to New Colony.
 - 12/ 4.5 kms of Alkaya Colony A/B/C be made mixed and R.C.C. drain be done from QSD to 700 ft (A/B/C).
 - 14/ 2.5 kms of Alkaya Colony A/B/C should be provided with Grade II.
 - 15/ Handicraft centre be established in the village.
