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① Major Complaint put forth by the people? -
The major complaint put forth by the people was regarding about PMAY. The reported that the major beneficiaries listed since 2016, have not received any payment. The demands put forth during B2V3 phase were not fulfilled.

② The major demand put forth during earlier B2V programs were not fulfilled and among them was one of the major demand i.e., installation of electric poles, replacement of old water pipes and open waste dumping sites.

③ My overall assessment: During my visit, I observed that the major demands of the people have not been fulfilled. They expressed their anger regarding the cold response shown by the government. However, the participation was at average level.

My suggestions to the authorities are that the promises made with the people should be fulfilled on priority basis so that people's confidence is restored to these democratic institutions.

④ During my field visit the overall response of the people towards the functioning of the government institutions was found to be at average level.
