Major Complaints Brought to the notice of the Visiting officer

The Locals Suffer due to lack of roads. The incomplete and halted work on Branward Road is a big blow for them. The quality of seeds provided by Agricultural department are not feasible - Execution of PMAY cases very slow and insufficient. Filthy, Untreated water is supplied. Health cards not sufficiently available -

Lack of Dispensary, Animal Husbandary, Sheep husbandary units and Ambulance. Job card holders don't get enough work days.

Schools and AWCs ~~don't~~ lack separate toilet for boys and girls. Locasward A and B Lack Primary School and AWC. Lack of power transmission poles and ~~to~~ lines. No Street light - Lack of playground. Repairing/Renovation and Construction of School buildings needed. IHHL urgent need - Widows and disabled need to be registered - Govt. Institutions and majority of households lack pits. Solar Units demanded - R-wells, fencing, footpaths, Check dams, awareness about government schemes needed -

The Halya Thum 'C' is hilly, steepy and difficult terrain, hence it is lagging behind on most of the developmental fronts. Be it education, Soc. Connectivity, Health, Agriculture, Self employment or Govt. Services etc.

Locals lack awareness about almost all government schemes. The Govt. Deptt. particularly Education, Y.S. & Sports, RDD, PHE, RSB, Health, Apiculture, Agriculture, Sericulture, IT, Banking, ICDS, Social Welfare, PDD, Animal and Sheep Husbandary and other departments need to provide awareness camps for this Halya.

The representatives of the departments need to visit this neglected, downtrodden area of Halya at earliest. The Halya deserves frequent visits by the concerned departments in order to ascertain the ground reality of their backwardness in almost all the fields especially development.

The youth and especially women need to provide training / awareness about self-help avenues so that they will be engaged in various self employment schemes. A panchayat ghar can change their outlook and a playground can provide healthy, productive and progressive future.
