1. UPS DatRashni needs separate Toilet Block Marshama and at least 02 rooms. 2 UPS Sharif Mohalla Sofi Mohalla needs a tile Path of 50 yard length and 20x80 (feet) Compound leveling / Tilting.
3. Sofi Mohalla path needs upgradation
4. UPS Tangpather needs Kitchen shed as the old one is dilapidated - 5, PMGSY Road Ladernag - Tangpather to Marshama is embanked & drainage and Retention walls need to be constructed.
5. At Arun Mohalla in ward 7 a Culvert needs to be constructed.
6. Health and Wellness centres also needs upgradation. (8) Ward 3 is not covered under ICDS. (9) Water supply pipes for Nagar Mohalla.

Shank Mohalla & for Mohalla under Capex Budget

needs to be undertaken before snowfall.
