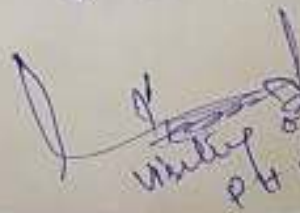

Major complaints brought to notice

Some major complaints that were brought to notice are-

- (1) The inhabitants of wailoo are totally unsatisfactory with the work culture of JK Gramin Bank. The concerned branch is full of ignorant and arrogant employees who misbehave with all the persons of village. Moreover most of the times these employees ~~could~~ ^{are} seen wandering on roads making it difficult for the villagers of wailoo to obtain anything.
- (2) The 2nd complaint is regarding Jal Shakti department who have been working on an scheme from last ten years and still not completed. All the villagers are compelled to drink dirty water. As per the villagers the ~~scheme~~ said scheme estimated cost was 7 Crore rupees and they say that we are totally confused where the money was utilised by the concerned department.
- (3) Other major complaint that was brought to notice was that a building for GHS wailoo was sanctioned at an amount of Rupees 73.46 lacs in year 2010-11. The work was taken up by R & B department and in such a huge amount they left the building incomplete. Despite the issue being brought in the notice of higher authorities, nothing was done in that case. Even the concerned Sarpanch lodged Grievance on Governor Grievance cell but all in vain. Now finally rupees 5 lacs under ADP were spent by concerned Sarpanch on the same building making it somewhat good for sitting.
