During the visit B2V4 I observed that PHE and PDD work very well. People of Panchayat complain that work recommended in B2V1, B2V2 and B2V3 is not started. I suggest that all the demand of Panchayat Lalehri should be approve. More funds need to be sanctioned at Panchayat level for the development of the Panchayat. Most of the Deptt. are good but few are not responding. Sarpanch of the Panchayat fully cooperate me in my two days visit at Panchayat Lalehri. GRS Raj Kumar and Yashpal also help me in different activities.
