

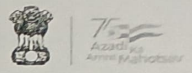
Overall Assessment and Suggestions





