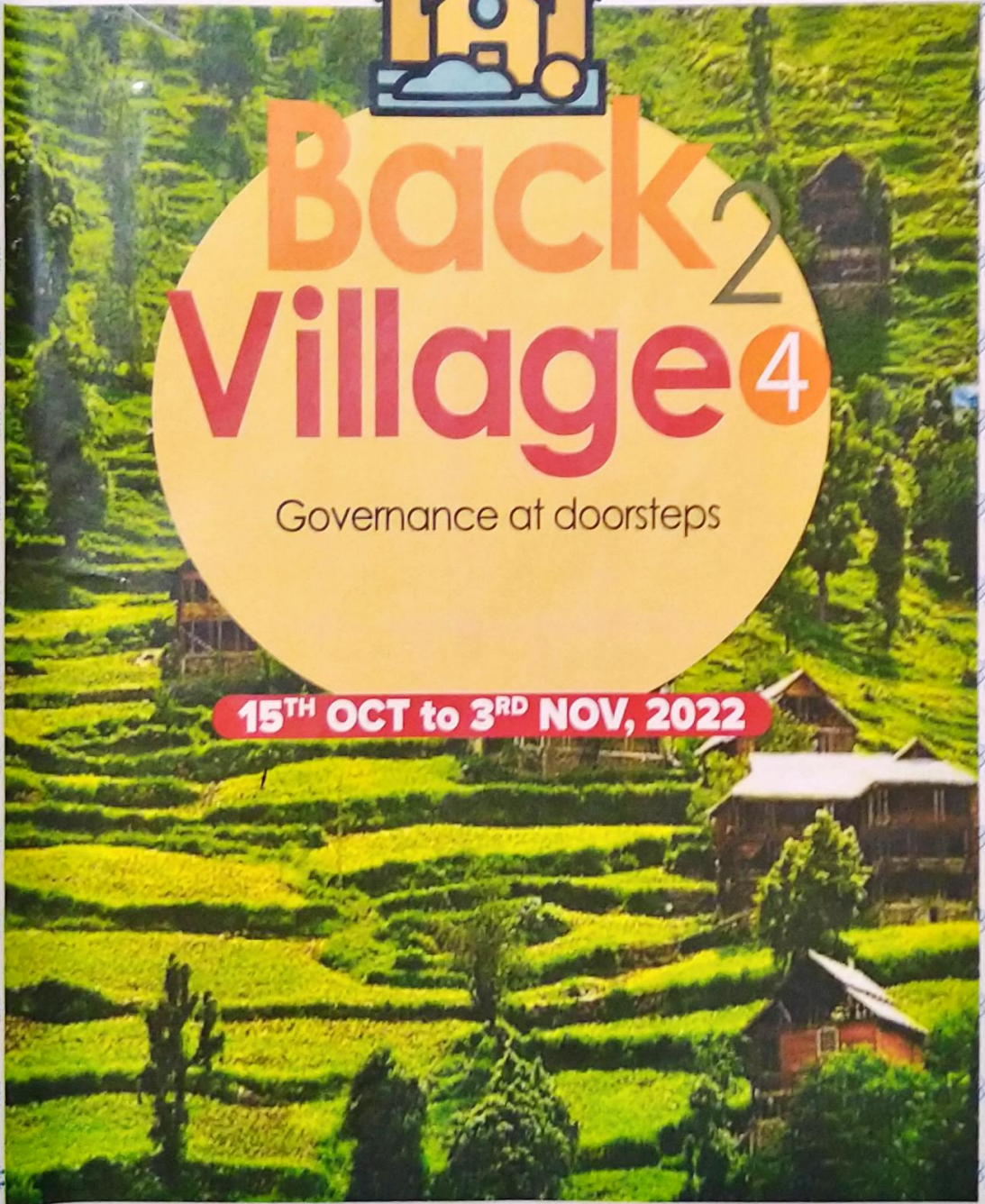

NOTES

1. The road from Zochdam to Nander Bala almost 3.5 km is in a dire state, only 2 km of it is macadamized. That too has developed pot holes. The remaining 1.5 km needs to be macadamized and it better so that it should be handed over to NABARD for its macadamization and advice.

2. Almost 50 bare electric poles for LT be provided to panchayat Halga so that all the hamlets will get their basic facilities without any disruption.

3. Three link roads be constructed as panchayat Halga is spread over various remote hamlets.

(i) From panchayat to Salphore - Ward (6)

(ii) Panchayat to Dhaba - Ward (5)

(iii) Main road to Checkpost - Ward (4)

4. A new building be constructed for community Health Centre (CHC) which is presently housed in a rented building without basic facilities like electricity, internal wash rooms, resting beds etc.

5. An animal husbandry centre/unit be set up in the Panchayat Halga. People are backward and are very much dependent on animals and their well being is their major source of income.

6. The panchayat as a whole has a huge scope for tourism and it is suggested that Panchayat Halga be included into tourist development programme and be provided with all basic facilities to attract the tourists. It is in place to mention that a herbal garden developed by some prominent panchayat persons could be the centre of attraction for the tourists and if developed it can be converted into a botanical garden.

NOTES

7. It was earlier demanded in previous B2V programmes that the only centre school in Panchayat Halga be upgraded into high school. A vast govt land for this purpose and for the availability of playground is available. But nothing concrete is done so far.

8. To make the water supply schemes very effective, the panchayat Halga be provided almost 125 no. of 1.5" and 125 no. of 0.75" pipes so that minor repairs can be executed by the lone man of the area.

9. A godown be constructed so that food supply for all wards be stored/dumped there and from where it can be supplied to other wards as and when required especially in winters.
