The department of social welfare which is mostly the implementing agency of individual beneficiary schemes not represented in BrV and the deliverables which were set for them to achieve remained unattended.

Suggestions:-


- It is suggested that the major organic demands during back to village programme should be fulfilled also people should be awarded regarding various schemes implemented by the Govt.
- ① There should be a separate head of funds under back to village so that the demands raised by the public will be fulfilled on time.
 - ② Death of staff of departments should be curbed with recruitment of officials so that regular follow up of the demands will be made possible.
