Respected Sir, Your kind attention is invited to the works to be executed through under the programme Bada village, mentioned hereunder, which were reflected previously in the meeting held in this behalf. Since no action was taken by the concerned Deptt, the matter is hereby brought to your formal notice once again and hope that the immediate action will be taken at an earliest.

1. Distribution of Land record of Bada, as per the records prepared during the consolidation
2. Expenditure of Rs 9 - 00 lacs) for replacement of drinking water pipes from Sangram / Canal to Peth Seer, the amount which has been already allotted to the Deptt, but no action has been taken so far.
