GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
2. He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative dept under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDO official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
6. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.

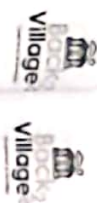

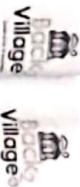

1. Anganwadi Centre in the village found working smoothly.
2. Every household has got electricity connection, and Pdd. dept. provides good services.
3. Agriculture dept. is doing a very good job in the area by providing seeds in time, and star tools and machines.
4. Rdd dept is working and plays Pivotal role in implementing various Govt. Schemes on ground. Besides provide good services to the people.

5. PHE dept. has miserably failed to provide drinking water to the residents of the said village. Services provided by the dept are worst. G.I Pipes in the village leak almost at every junction. No repairing of them G.I Pipes has been done, I saw then G.I Pipes in the same condition two years back, when I visited the village on V.O B2V3. Hence people are agitated at the attitude of the PHE dept.

Others seems no accountability to students of the
said village by the concerned Z.T.O. As during
inspection 91 was observed, children from both
GPS- & 88. PS. Pujari & P.S. many were not able
to read & write properly besides, cannot perform
basic mathematical operations.
