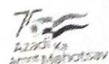

Overall Assessment of the visit
During B2V4 phase
(28-10-2022 to 29-10-2022)

During my two days visit of Panchayat Chandel, Block Bani, Teh. Bani and Dist. Kathua in the capacity of visiting officer I Ramon Chandel made the following assessments.

1. People of the area are very co-operative and peaceful but lack awareness regarding various Govt. schemes that have been launched by the Govt. aiming at the improvement of standards of the masses.
2. Various demands that were made during previous Back to village phase i.e. B2V1, B2V2 and ~~B2V3~~ were not resolved so far and remain unattended. People showed peaceful resentment for not fulfilling of their demands.
3. Their main demand was regarding improvement of basic facilities like, pure water, electricity, roads, transportation, upgradation of schools.
4. People feel that the Govt. is doing everything good for the masses but they are not availing the schemes due to lack of knowledge and exposure but are well aware of programmes like Nasha Mukhti, SBM and good governance. They do not complain about any corruption charges against any department.
5. During the visit all stakeholders especially Sarpanch and PRIs of the village cooperated with the under signed.

Suggestions

It is my humble request to higher authorities that the long pending demands of the people may be resolved before B2V5.
