GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
2. He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
6. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.
7. Focus of visit are youth, skills, self-employment, nasha mukt, bhrashtachar mukt, Rozgar yukt J&K, besides to carry forward the activities during Jan Abhiyan and saturate them.

General public grievances.

1. HSS Kandoora lacks infrastructure, insufficient staff and a playground.
 2. GMS Kandoora faces burning issues in the building which have been verbally declared unsafe for the teaching and learning process but unfortunately other educational institutions are also working in the same unsafe building. So the major demand of the general public is to construct the new building for GMS, BPS and SSA Kandoora for the safety of students.
 3. The Panchayat Ghar is in pathetic condition and lacks basic facilities, and needs major repairment and also the dispute with the land owner needs to be resolved.
 4. Providence of electrical poles, electrical wires and transformers to whole panchayat halqa Kandoora as the response of the general public towards the PDD is very much aggressive and unsatisfactory.
 5. Health and wellness centre needs its own building as the rented building lacks all types of basic facilities for staff as well as the patients. And also needs upgradation keeping in view the population and catchment area of the panchayat halqa Kandoora.
 6. Macadamization of link roads between Kandoora to Goripora, Alhadith Eidgah to Rankipora and internal link roads from Gowisa Masjid to the House Of Mr Farooq Ahmed Malik, House of Mr Muhammad Ramzan Parry To IEI Kandoora and Jamia Hanifa To House Of Mr Muhammad Yousuf Mir and the inhabitants of Bon Khah.
 7. Separate Aganwadi Centres for Malik mollaha, Wari mollaha, Zandwan, Chana Mohalla and Charkhun village.
 8. Keeping in view the typical topography of the village the general public demanded the bunds within the village at different locations for conservation of soil and to stop landslides.
 9. Separate government buildings with all proper facilities for animal husbandry as most of the inhabitants are engaged in cattle farming.
 10. The general public mentioned the issues they have been facing regarding the availability of the banking sector in the village and demanded for a bank branch.
 11. Non-availability of a playground in the village has hurt the youth of the village as the demand has been raised in all the previous back-to-village programmes so needs to be resolved.
 12. The youth demanded implementation of industrial training programmes and skill development schemes so they can manage to feed their families.
 13. Connecting road between HSS Kandoora to Larnud along with lined road.



Overall assessment of the visit and suggestions by visiting officer.

The participation of the general public was not up to mark as the major demands highlighted in the previous back-to-village programmes were still unfulfilled. Moreover, the burning issue was about the safety and security of the students as well as staff at GMS Kandoora which is also matter of concern to be taken into sympathetic consideration by higher authorities keeping in view the sensitivity of the matter. While having a conversation with the youth of kandoora where they demanded playground and implementation of industrial training programmes and skill development schemes so they can take part and can manage to feed their families. Above all people of kandoora were very loud and opinionated about the difficulties they have been facing because of non-availability of banking sector where they demanded the bank branch. During my visit to Health & wellness centre I found the centre working in one room without basic facilities and not eco-friendly to patients as its located in the 1st floor with narrow stairs So my personal request to concerned medical authorities to investigate the matter as the centre is open violation of proper norms as the particular centre doesn't come in the norms required for Health and Wellness Centre. During the visit to above said place people and the concerned staff along with locals were very angry regarding to said method. People particularly mentioned that we lack the basic facilities regarding health and wellness. The general public requested the up gradation of Health and Wellness centre.
