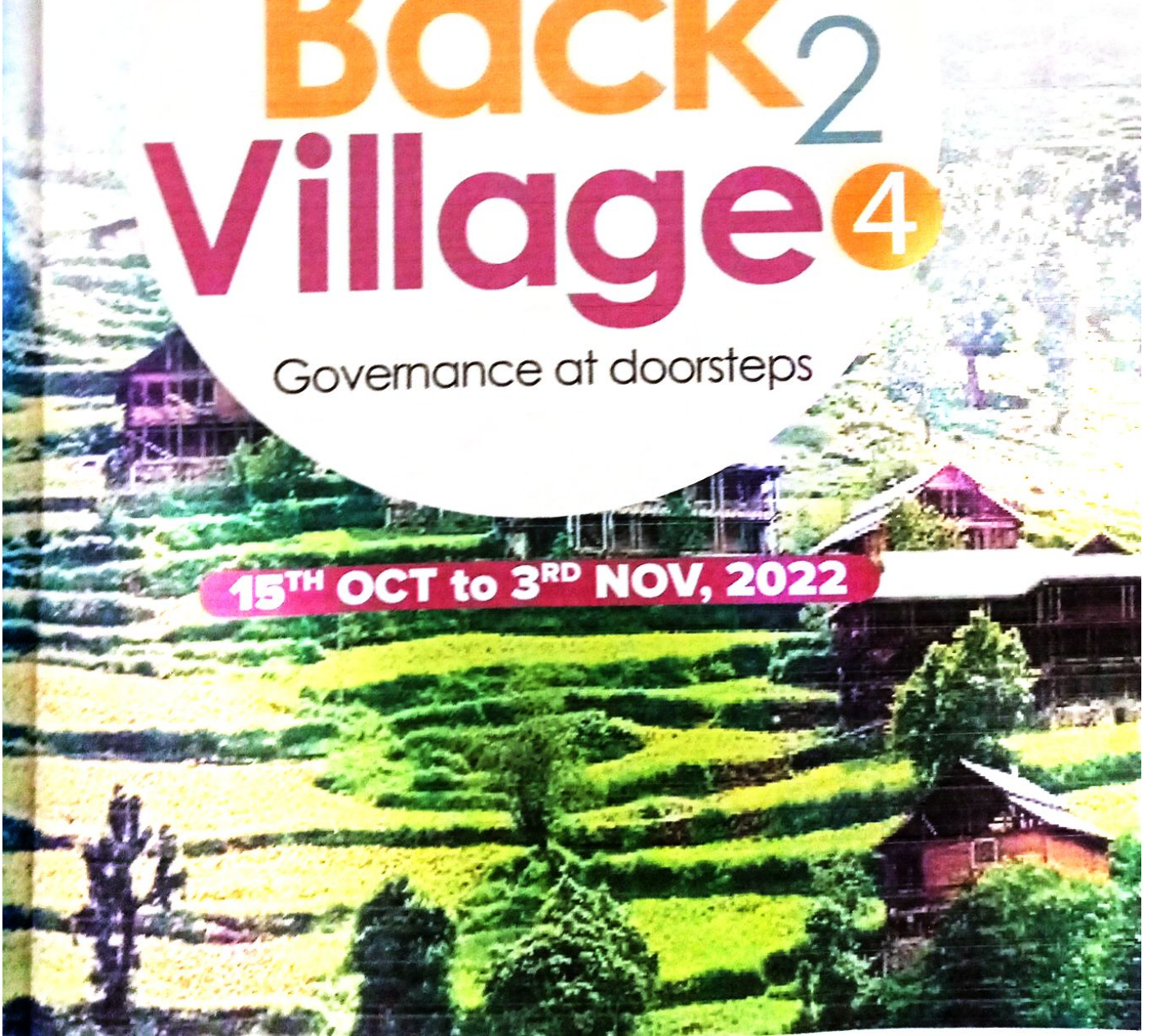

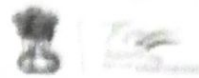

During my two days visit of Panchayat Balmola, Block Balmola, Teh. Bani and Dist. Bikaner in the capacity of Visiting Officer Dharam Chand ^{IAS} made the following assessment.

1. People of the area are very co-operative and peaceful and lack awareness regarding various Govt. schemes that have been launched by the Govt. aiming at the improvement of standards of masses.
2. The major demands projected during previous B₂V₁, B₂V₂ and B₂V₃ had been addressed by the concerned department. However minor demands projected that time still to be addressed. In connection to this the public show resentment.
3. In addition to that the people of Panchayat Balmola escalated some demands which are as under.
 - (i) Sanction of veterinary animal husbandary in Panchayat
