DELIVERABLES AND RECORD DEFICIENCIES IF ANY

- Visited/Inspected the construction of AWC (Anganwasi Centre) at Chamkole - B found sub standard of material used, handsome amount is sanctioned ^{under} AOP scheme GRD (8.00 lac) but the work is not upto mark.
- No building is sanctioned for Panchayat Ghar as such a single room with no facilities is provided for the activities of Panchayat which is not sufficient.
- Inspected almost all ICDS centres which are without building ~~people~~ public demanded for construction of ICDS buildings.
- Visited UPS Chikarkote (A middle school) accommodated in three rent free rooms (shed) nicely decorated walls painted with learning objects whereas the govt building of the school is unusable as there is a need of protection wall and a drain & a repairing cost for the moment the school is unusable because of the leaking water from the damaged irrigation Kool. Repairing is also recommended for the school building.
- Inspected the dilapidated lintel level building of ZEO office Chamkole (Education) which was constructed in 2012-13 but it is damaged and spoiled although 15 Marlas prime land is occupied for the purpose hence recommended for sanction of new ~~school~~ building for ZEO office.

NOTES

- A link road is demanded from PHE to Nallea upto 1 km only.
Visited Govt Hms Gundiydon, fencing of the school and protection wall from roadside is demanded by the PRIs/Staff and parents.
- Inspection of schools (BMS/Hms Chuterkoti, Hms G. Singh and ICDS Centres at Chuterkoti, Gundiydon) was done during the visit and found upto mark. Their record is maintained nicely.
- Inspected Amritsarovar constructed near home of Javed Ahmad in ward-1 also inspected of pit for waste water management in the Panchayat.
- Inspected the houses constructed out of PMAY by RDD judiciously for BPH families.
- Also inspected the construction of road from Chuterkoti (Chanku B) to Khorian via Chamba.
- PRIs complained of irresponsible attitude of Agriculture department they claimed that Agriculture department neither provides quality seeds/appliances nor technical support to farmers. They argued the representative of Agriculture department and complained their complete failure.
- People also demanded rejuvenation/renewal of water supply line in the Panchayat halga and a public park at Rimal Koti in between Chuterkoti and Peer Panjows/Gundiydon.
- ≡ All the people unanimously demanded for construction of Sadhna Tunnel and ST status to Pahari Speaking people.
- A water reservoir for drinking water suffice is also demanded.

NOTES

- Requirement of NTPC with sanction of atleast 3 doctors and paramedical staff as it suffice half of the population of Tehsil Karnah. Presently a single doctor performs all the tasks at NTPC.

- People demanded upgradation of GMS Chittankole to GHS (Secondary School) level as there is no girls Secondary School in the block.

- Demanded construction of pathrann near Nehr monallah for ICDS Centre in Peer Panjawa. Footpath from Road to PS Peer Panjawa.

- Demanded sanction of Fire Service Station at Chittankole Nijabat.

MGNREGA staff is working in RDD department with deduction of honesty, the general public has requested the govt that the contract staff employed under MGNREGA be regularized and their salary may please be released on time. The Panchayat Secretary is the only bridge b/w govt & Panchayat, the designation of Panchayat Secretary may be changed to Panchayat Development officer.

Opening of Food & Supply Store at village Gundi Sydan is again requested not taken yet.

- A protection wall to protect the Patti Jabb of village from floods in Nalah Kajmang & Bata maji.

A tourist spot be constructed/established at Naliyan behind Chittankole village.

- Extension Horticulture Office in the village & Tubular structure Green house damaged, also Verm Compost Unit (VCU) may plz be established.
