## NOTES

- ⇒ General Public has demanded Health Sub Centre for village Kathams.
- ⇒ Request to Kathams road its construction and completion.
- ⇒ Construct near Health and welfare centre, repairment of School building in the Gram Panchayat, High School for Gram Panchayat.
- ⇒ The major problems faced by the public of Samari is non availability of road connectivity and non availability of network. It has also been demanded that protection work and works like land development etc should be taken in the Panchayat in order to protect residential houses from damage of soil erosion.

During the visit it was observed that general public of the Panchayat is being neglected only the Schemes of RDD like MYNREKA, ADR, MYSR PMAY etc are being carried out while rest of the Schemes from various Deptt. are yet to reach the Gram Panchayat. The people of the area are unaware about rest of the world due to non availability of network.


It is suggested that due care be given towards the Panchayat. Installation of mobile network towards construction of inner link roads. Posting of regular Doctor in the Panchayat. Establishment of food stores in Tolihaji, Phagran and Kathams.



## Major Problems in Halqa Seemari

- 1) Non availability of Roads in Panchayat: The general public has demanded link roads in Seemari Panchayat.
  - 2) Non availability of Mobile Network: The area is cutoff in terms of network general public have demanded installation of mobile network in Panchayat.
  - 3) Non availability of Drinking water: The Panchayat is rich in water sources but there are no PHE pipes water tanks through which water can be provided to all households. As such gram Sabha have demanded repairment of old water pipes and new pipes in the Panchayat.
  - 4) Non availability of electricity: The area is living in dark the electric wires are put on trees etc. As such gram Sabha have demanded repairment of electric poles, wires and installation of new transformers.
  - 5) Tourist Hubs: The area is having good potentials of tourist attraction as such public have demanded construction of tourist hut at Seemari.
  - 6) Building for food stores: Public have demanded food store building in Seemari.
- It has come to forth the people of the Panchayat face acute problem due to non availability of link road which can connect Panchayat Seemari with Sub Division Indore. Hence construction of link road under major project be taken up on priority basis.


