Major Complaints:- No measure complaint was brought in my notice by the locals of Waripora Panchayat.

Major/urgent demands reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:- Construction of Panchayat Garh at Waripora. This demand is in place since the beginning of Back to Village programme. Though the construction was started but wasn't completed due to many reasons. No other major demand has been left untouched.

Over-all assessment:- The overall assessment of the Panchayat is Satisfactory. Almost all the Govt. Schemes for the benefit of the general public have been saturated and have reached the grass-root level. It was an obvious deduction that the Panchayat is energizing and renewing the developmental aspects to standardize the level of living by schemes ranging from providing SBM/HHH units to technical institutions like ITI.

However it struck me hard and harshly to see the devastating condition of Govt. Schools. No basic facilities, no infrastructure, quite heart wrenching to see our future in such a miserable condition.
