GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS



It was really a hectic schedule full of activities all around. Observation of two days in Panchayat, various Government schemes are implemented at ground (Grass root) level.

The officials (Persons) from various departments like Employment, Agriculture, Horticulture, Sheep husbandry, Sericulture, Revenue, Rural department gave awareness regarding different schemes and its benefits for people, availing them.

visited different institutions, infrastructure projects and got first hand information regarding functioning and delivery. People of Panchayat Halga Hanjan, actively participated in different activities of Panchayat including formation of GPDP.

Interacted with the self-help groups, put forward some demands like Training Center for SHGs in Panchayat Halga Hanjan. Visited ~~the~~ health and wellness center (HWC) — equipments and supply of medicine in sufficient quantity, but they requested for new building for HWC. My school my pride, visit, check, water electricity, meet students and staff, found satisfactory. Primary school Hanjan demands fencing wall and protection Bund.

PMAY scheme, The beneficiaries are satisfied with the scheme, departmental cooperation and release of timely instalments. But there are also other

deserving people demand assistance through this scheme list enclosed to B₂V₂₄ Booklet.

Two SDG, themes approved for Panchayat Halga Hanjar — clean and green village, 2nd water sufficient village. To achieve SDG goals, lot has to be done in this direction. Initiatives has taken by the Panchayat like Solid and liquid waste management (Soak and Composite pits), and solar light installation, but still a lot has to be achieved.

Water sufficient village. Even though a lot has been changed and achieved last couple of years like water pipe connections to all households and many other things, but people still demand pure water especially which is a concern in rainy days. Repairment of main pipe lines and upgradation of Filtration Plant at Behibagh is an issue. Revenue department performs satisfactory, but Patwaris demand Patwari Khanna for Panchayat and creation of Patwari Halga as large area is covered by single Patwari.

Interacted with youth of Panchayat, a demand need to be addressed and is neglected every time is play ground. The whole Panchayat Halga does not have a single play ground even though state land is available, but authorities fail to fulfil this demand.

At last I hope authorities may consider these demands/suggestions and make this Panchayat (Hanjar) healthy, prosperous and green Panchayat.




