3. Capturing economic potential of the panchayats to synchronize them with decentralization goals


Undertaking unbiased assessment of needs of villages

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her abservation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.






