





Major Complaints noticed by visiting officer

- No connectivity (Pukka-path) of roads at Dhalian and Rajal-Rot till date as the public of the said area suffering from hardships since 50 years ago.
- The connectivity through bridge has not been available for the people of Dhalian since 50 years ago.
- There is no water connectivity for the people of Dhalian.
- The Condition of Rajal Rot Primary School and Dhalian Primary School are worst and public demand for new construction of the said schools.
- Toilet and Drinking water facility not available at Primary School Rajal Rot + Dhalian respectively. Further, the public of the said area demands for more staff in the said school + also requested for establishment of Anganwadi Centres at Dhalian + Rajal Rot.
- Establishment of P.H.C & veterinary Centre at Panchayat Rajal Rot.

Major / urgent public demands that was / were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far.

- The above mentioned complaints reflected in the demands of earlier Back to village Conducted on the instructions of the Government and ^{have} not been addressed so far.


Overall Assessment of the Visit + Suggestions of the visiting officer

- I visited at Dhalian and it has been observed that the inhabitants of the said ward (Approx. 400 locals including old age and children) has been suffering ^{from} since long due to non-availability of Road and Bridge in the said area. Further, as reflected by ~~the~~ some senior citizens of the said

area that few peoples were expired during floods & lost their beloved because of non availability / Connectivity of road as well as Bridge in the said area. Further, observed that there is no water facility at Dhallian till date. As far as Primary School is concerned it has been observed that the condition of the building is unsatisfactory and needs urgent inspection from the concerned department for assessing the strength of the building as the same was constructed in 1962 as stated by the public of Dhallian.

Assessment of Rajal Kot

I also visited Rajal Kot area and observed that the road Connectivity for the general public is not in proper manner. ~~and~~ Due to which inhabitants (more than 300) like old age and children suffering badly to reach one place to another place. Further, the building of the primary school Rajal Kot has also been inspected and found that only one room is functional for students of Ist to 5th class and rest of the building is in worst condition and non-functional. Moreover, only one teacher has been posted for ~~whole~~ Ist to 5th classes and toilet / drinking water facility is also not available for the students. ^{however} Anganwari Centres are also not available at Dhallian & Rajal Kot respectively.

The above assessment needs immediate consideration as the public of the Dhallian & Rajal Kot (Panchayat Rajal-A) are suffering since decades and they have  of hope from Back to village of Conducted by Government through visiting officers deputed for the purpose.

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
