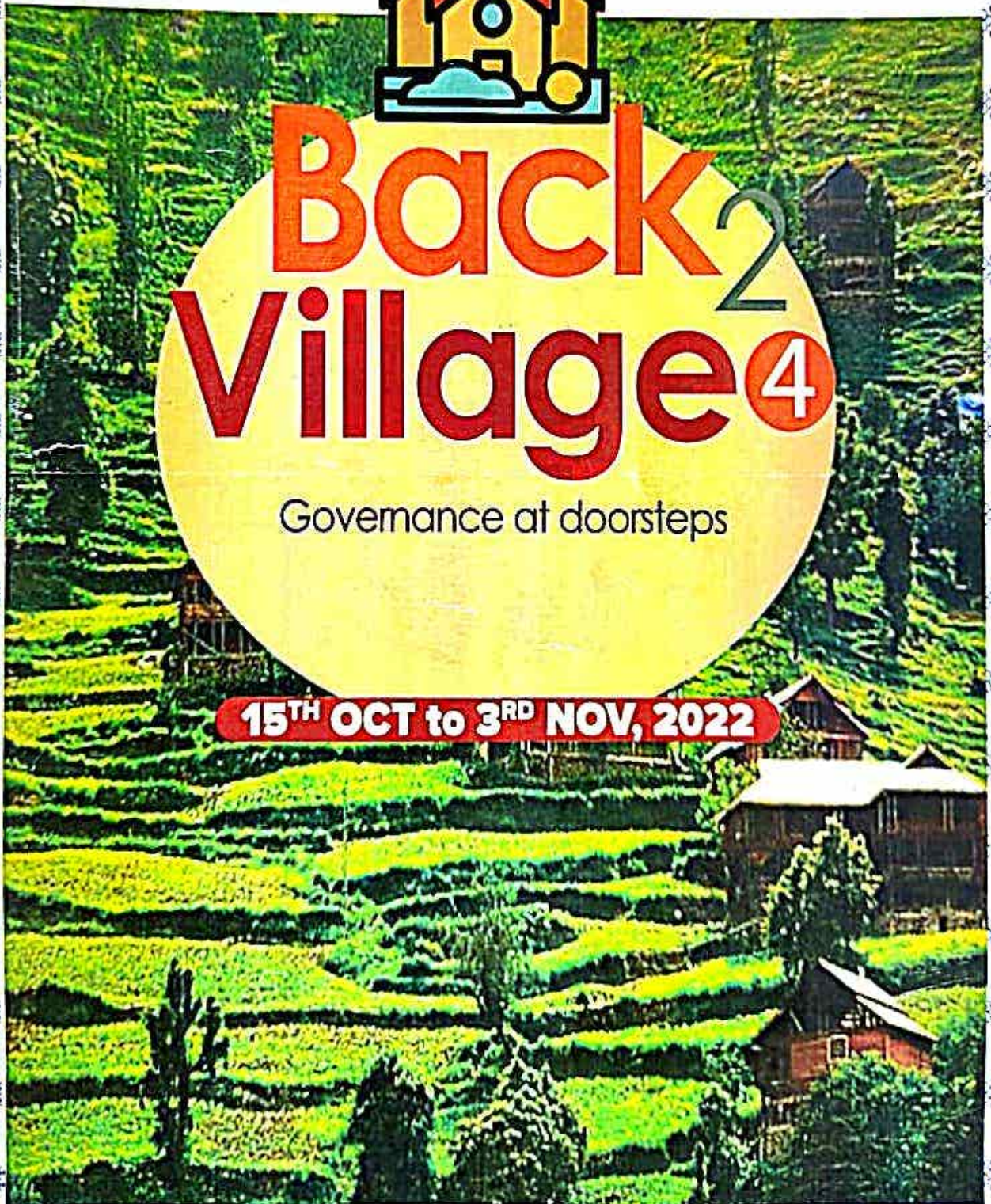

Meanwhile the visiting officer visit Govt. Hr/Sec. school Navagobara to attend the sports event and ensure them to conduct the same on regular basis.

(At 02:00 Pm) The visiting officer visit the PHC Navagobara and enquire about Health facilities.

(At 03:00 Pm) The visiting officer visited the AWC's and schools to enquire about the faculty-cum-facility. However the deficiencies found in any area is mentioned in the demands list.

(At 4:30 Pm) The visiting officer checked/inspect the Amrit-Sarovar works being carried out in the respective Panchayats. However the works of Rainwater Harvesting is completed but till date their material amount lying pendency.

During the visit Sarpanch, Naib-Sarpanch and PRI's of the Gram Panchayat and all other front-line workers, Stake-holders, Senior Citizens have co-operated and put into place their genuine demands. Most of the issues were resolved on the spot. The overall assessment remain quite satisfactory.
