

02. Opening up of more ICDS Centres in Halpa particularly in villages of Hamhona and Hashangpora as the current centres are not able to cater the needs.
03. Establishment of Receiving Station
04. Upgradation of sub-centre to Primary health Centre.
05. The Veterinary extension Centre present in Urpara is in shambles without proper building and no space for insemination/vaccination of cattle, needs proper accommodation for staff and ground/place for insemination.
06. The building of UPS-Urpara is unsafe and needs to be dismantled and reconstructed.
