GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
- 2. He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
- 3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
- 4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
- 5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
- 6. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.

During Panchayat Level Convergence Meeting, the GS passed the following resolution for adopting in the current fiscal year :- (decisions taken during GS meeting of 22-10-2022 reviewed)

- 01- Transfer of identified state land by the Revenue department to Health Department, preparing of DPR by R&B Department and execution of work, i.e, construction of building for Health and Wellness Centre. The amount received by the PRI from Railway on account of compensation of state land be utilized for this purpose.
- 02- Village sanitation plan formulated by the RDD discussed focus on fixation and collection of fee from all sanctions of society, hiring of labour, segregation of waste ,identification of dumping site, signing of MoU with Municipality ,Const. of Compost and soakage pits was laid. Mohalla Committees were constituted to help the local administration.
- 03- To solve the drainage problem ,it was decided that the outflow from the constructed drain be taken into irrigation canal after ensuring that it is free from all suspended and other wastes. It has a direct bearing on sanitation plan because only the surface water (Rain) and water from the households be taken into the drainage system.
- 04- Drainage issue of new colonies shall be taken up with ERA as it requires huge funds, however whatever possible steps for stopping inundation of water shall be taken up the local authorities.
- 05- Improvement of roads in the continuous process and shall be death with all possible measures.
- 06- Installation of street lights by the PDD also came into the discussion and it was decided that PDD shall install street lights at identified spots.

Funds under current financial year shall be utilized for the above works only.
