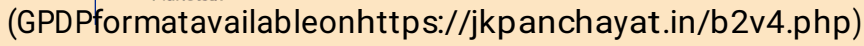

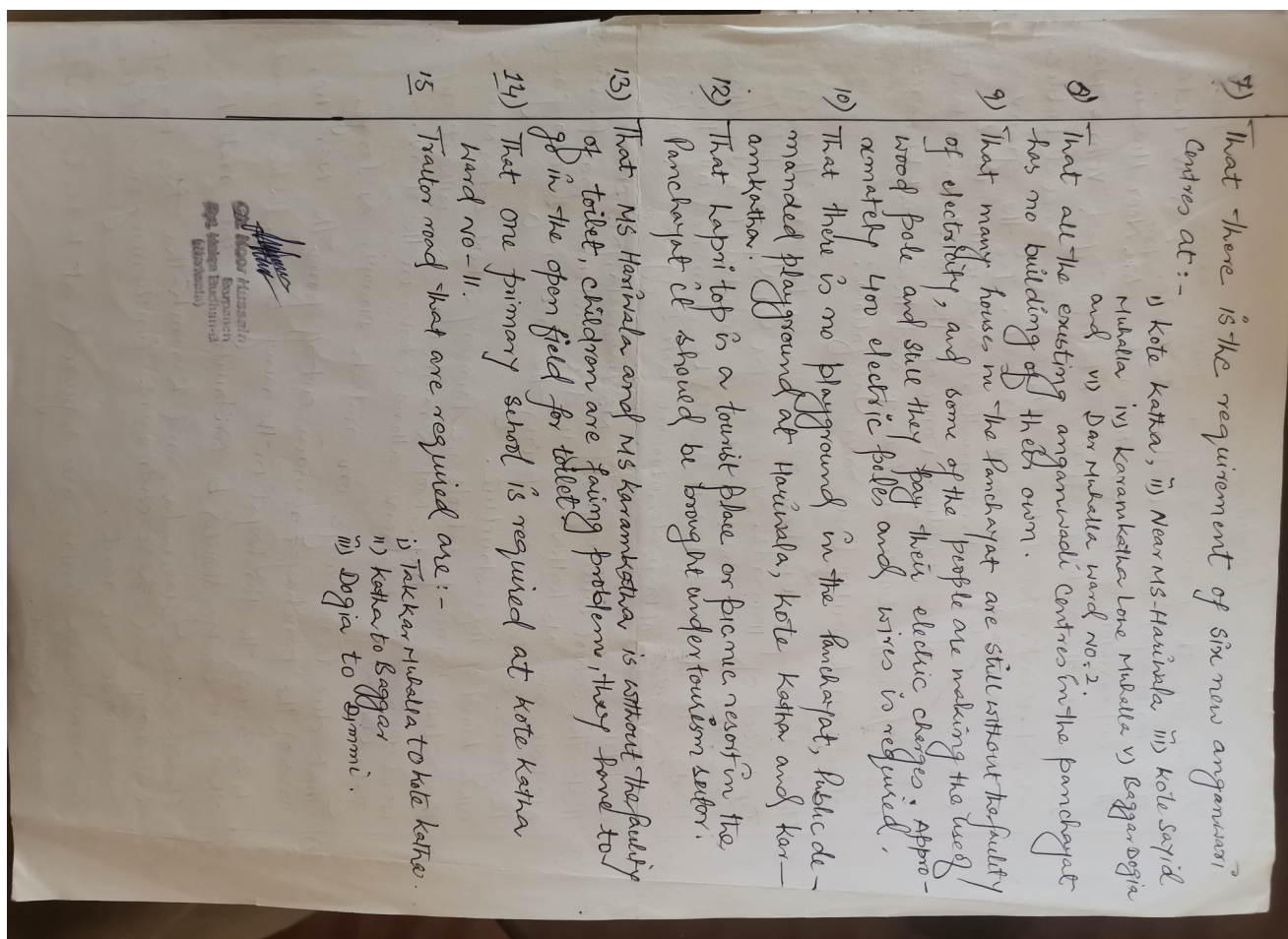

Resolution

Today on 21st of Oct, 2022, a gram sabha was held at Panchayat House Buchan-B, under B.S.V-V, under the supervision of Halpa Samparch, ^{Chairman} Mohan Hussain, in which the visiting officer Khalid Saad Vohra, was also present, as well as P.R.O and general public of the panchayat was also present. In the gram sabha many important matters and issues were highlighted by the public. Some of the most important issues that the public is facing and that must be resolved on priority basis are as follows:

- 1) That Panchayat Buchan-B is a very big area that is comprised of 11 wards. It is a far flung and hilly area, the roads flows in it that divided it into three parts, we demand that it should be demarcated into three panchayats, i.e. Hainiwala, Dimmi-Kote Beggar and in Karankatha.
- 2) That the school buildings of MS-Hainiwala, MS-Dimmi, MS-Kote and MS-Katha are under construction from previous 12 years. Children are facing the problem of building and other kind of infrastructure.
- 3) That two primary schools, i.e. Primary School Lohamuhalla and Primary School Karankatha are without any ward no-2 and PM school children attend classes in the open.
- 4) That due to no bridge on mallah Dimmi, a large area of the panchayat remain cut off from the world no, 1, 2, 3, 4 of the Panchayat in the rainy season. Public demand that foot bridge should be constructed on this mallah.
- 5) Health Centre Hainiwala and Karankatha has no govt. building and these centres are functioning in tent-tail house on rent.
- 6) Two new health centres are required at Kote Beggar and Dimmi.

GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISTING OFFICER

I Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:
The demands raised in previous Back to village visits are yet to be met

II Major/urgent public demand that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed far:
Infrastructure especially Toilets in Schools (Only 3 out of 11 schools have a toilet. Even in these schools there is no facility for separate toilets for males and females)
Hamlet level Road Connectivity is required.

III Overall assessment of the visit and suggestions:
work being done to take the schemes/programmes at the ground level is quite appreciable. The transparency is visible. The biggest hindrance now is lack of awareness:

Suggestions:

1. There are eleven Schools in the panchayat and none of these schools meet the basic norms as prescribed by RTE 2009. 7 Schools do not have a single toilet let alone separate toilets. The buildings are in a dilapidated condition. Some schools have only walls with no roof. Substandard material has been used. Some of these schools are functioning in one room, some in two and some in three rooms and many of these require repair. What happened to SSF funds? SWACH Bharat Swach Vidhyalya Abhiyan of 2014?

The school education department should immediately grant funds for construction of these school buildings as per RTE 2009 norms through e-tendering and also order re-audit of Funds meant for the construction of these schools.

2. The Panchayat is more suitable for Horticulture and not agriculture. The Horticulture department should organise awareness camps and let people benefit from the schemes/programmes.

3. Livestock rearing is a traditional occupation of the people of the region. The department of Animal Husbandry should actively promote their programme as it can provide employment to a lot of youth.



4.The RDD department should ensure maximum participation of people in decision making process by publicising the dates of Gram Sabha and ward sabha meetings. Those demands which will help in the development of community as a whole should be prioritised over others.

5. The AWCs under ICDS project should be made more efficient by training/orientation programmes.The checks and balances should be placed atleast daily geo tagged photos.

6. The Civil works department should make the billing process more prompt.

7.According to the public at large the KCC loan is not being used for development of Agriculture in the area.Instead, it is being used as personal loan. It has led to accumulation of debt as the poor people take more than what is required and later lend money from local money lenders. Instead, the loan should be disbursed account to account in favour of service providers and others.




