GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER

Any major complaints brought to the notice of the visiting officer:

Two complaints were received.

- 01. One Mr. Sadam Hussain S/O Mohd Shabir R/O village Mahari Gajjaran complained that he did not receive payment for construction of tractor road in Mehari Gujjaran. The complaint was handed over to BDO Rajouri for sorting out the issue.
- 02. One Mr. Ifthikar Hussain S/O Fatha Mohd R/O villagr Maheri Gujjaran complained that his case for a house under AWAS Plus was rejected on the ground that he was already living in a pcca house, whereas the pacca house did not belong to him. The complaint was handed over to BDO Rajouri to readdress the grievance of the complainant.
- ii Major / urgent public demands that was / were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:
 - 1. Water supply by way of lift system or Bore well 06 No
 - 2. Community Hall / Marriage Hall in the Panchayat
 - 3. PHC with Ambulance
 - 4. Up-gradation of School from Primary to Middle School, Middle School to High School and road from Pallulian to Sawani
 - 5. Animal / Sheep husbandry sub center
 - 6. Road from Pangala via Khori to Javid Mohra
- iii Overall assessment of the visit and suggestion:

Overall functioning of the Gram Panchayat was good. Small public demands are being met within the available resources. Major demands have not been met most probably due to heavy financial implications.

Road connectivity is must for development of any area. The demand for road construction is quite genuine and needs to be given due consideration. Besides, existing roads require black topping. There is no High School in the Gram Panchayat

and the nearest High School is about 10 Km away from the Govt. Middle School Mehari Gujjaran which can be upgraded to the level of a High School. Facilities for primary smart classes and development of play fields are required to be considered for the Schools. Existence of a PHC along with an Ambulance will lessen the health related problems of the people. Unemployment issue can be addressed by skill development of youth, implementation of self employment schemes and focused attention on Agricultural / Horticultural production. 06
