- Water supply scheme for the panchayat stands sanctioned but the tendering process delayed due to high cost of Project as such there is urgent need to revisit DPR so that the work is started as soon as possible.
- Upgradation of UPS Paneen from Middle School to High School.
- Completion of Gaddi Nalla to Dugga via Gotha Road.
- Repair and renovation of damaged room of UPS Paneen.

Overall assessment of the visit and suggestions.

- Most of the people expressed their disappointment that the demands projected earlier were not fulfilled as such demanded that all the major works be done under B2V programme as these are being noted down by the officers after assessing the actual ground situation.
- No new registration is being allowed for Ration Cards as such people demanded early new registrations.
- Awareness regarding Government Scheme needs to be expedited.
- Gram Sabha needs to be made more proactive.
- Awaajplus pending cases be taken on priority.
- Approval of MGNREGA works at an earliest.
