Overall assessment details of visits and suggestions thereof. (PH. YARBUGH)
on 31-10-22

During the visit, it was found that all the departments were functioning smoothly. They provided full support to us to make it successful. All faculty of various departments co-operated very amicably.

- ① Anganwari workers and helpers must be made more accountable and the Sarpanch should visit often to these centres. However, their honorarium be enhanced for their minimum possible livelihood.
- ② Need of Primary Health Sub-Centre :- There is need of health subcentre for timely medication of people. As they move to nearby village for the simplest of medical aid. The present population of village is sufficient enough to be provided with dispensary.
- ③ Ration Ghat :- The village is in dire need of its own Ration Ghat. People find it very hard to go to other village for this basic facility.
- ④ School Building :- As far as school buildings are concerned, they are present but two of its buildings are dilapidated and very old. Thus, providing threat to both School students and teaching staff. Moreover, the boundary walls should be reconstructed to protect whole land dedicated to school. The upgradation to high school is need of an hour. As students of same village leave studies halfway because of the same reason.

5) Common Service Centre (CSC) and ATM services to be provided to the said village.

6) Drinking water facilities to Sardar Mohalla and Bhatat Mohalla is needed at its earliest.

7) Electric Poles To Dodigund be provided to avoid any accident. Because, of the reason that electric poles are decayed wooden poles.

8) Animal Husbandary and Sheep Dispensary to be provided. As most of the population is related to livestock and poultry.

9) Financial Assistance to Apple Growers:-
Apple Growers witnessed a great loss during the current year. No one is ready to buy their fruits at reasonable prices. As most of the population of area is absorbed in agronomy, resulting in unemployment, financial crisis and thus heavy tax loss to the UT.

10) Solar Plant to Panchayat Ghar:- Panchayat Ghar should be well established and be provided with the solar plant facility.

11) Providing Accommodation for VO's and CLF's of Self Help Groups:-

As the groups were formed for the livelihood mission and making females independent and empowered they pay their own rents for their village offices and CLF's. They should be provided by the same.

12) Need of Skill Development Centres for Females:-
Females of village demanded separate centres for traditional work like zari, rani, paper mache etc. They also demanded sewing centres to enable them to get their own livelihood.
