Major and urgent demands of Panchayat Halga Khanda completion of Water Tanky orlingwila Filtration Plant has been stopped by unknown persons. The people demand line from Haborgh grid to Receiving Station Khanda. Also the young folk demands for play field near Kuzhna.

Complaint of People

The people of Khanda complaints against non completion of Water Tanky within a dead line period and Filtration plant as the people of village Khanda are badly suffering from impure drinking water which is a basic need for living.

OVERALL ASSESSMENT

The overall assessment of undersigned is that in fear of the people of Khanda village ^{Shore} are suffering due to ^{po} of pure drinking water facility. As per the statement of Sarpanch and one of the Employee of PDD Rs 800000 have been lapsed in current session which were meant for poles and other repairment of wire etc. The net for 33000 kv is pending in the office of PDD concerned but no one bother to take action or to get it utilised in the said village in order to save people from any life loss. The concerned quarters are humbly requested to look into the matter and get the net or any other safe measure utilised for 33000 kv.

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A action taken by the department of P.H.E. is providing pure drinking water to people of village Khandu which has given some relief to common man to some extent. To me the water supply is not easily be completed within a prescribed time. So the villagers will not suffer any more. The water crisis in this village is a continuous and prolonged thing because of demand of people.
