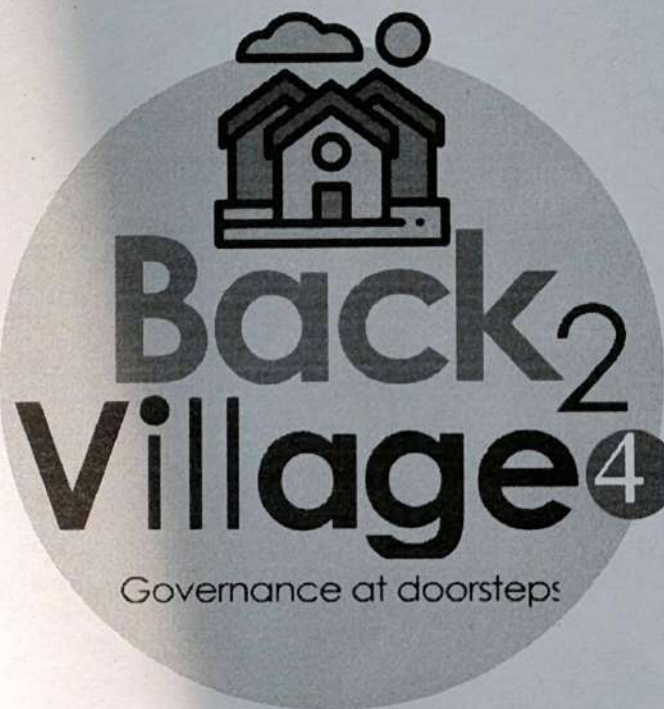

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER

I Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer

1. Excessive release of escape water from power Canal into escape Nallah. No earlier warning system which has put life of humans & live stock in danger. Earlier raised this demand in B2V1, B2V2, B2V3 but no action taken so far.
2. Gane Mohalla residents complained about damage caused by wild animals to their crops & put the lives of humans & live stock in danger. So fencing needed from forest side was demanded earlier but no action taken place so far.

II

Major/ urgent public demands that was/ were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:

1. Deficiency of classrooms in Middle school Frawhaknara. as only 04 rooms are available for 00 classes. Roll is about 100- but After visiting the School premises 3-4 classes are held in one room. Urgent need to construct school building.
2. Deficiency of Electric poles, wire. Electric network system need to be improved. Concerned Lineman also reported that the electric ~~boxes~~ conductors are laged with weak wooden poles near residential houses which may cause major accident. So demand is genuine & need urgent addressed.
3. upgradation of sub centre to health & wellness centre. Where atleast one doctor, one staff nurse, ECG Technician X-ray Technician, Pharmacist may remain available for public. The Panchayat halga has about 244 house holds which has to move to PHC Gund / Gannwar during cold winters to consult a doctor. Urgent & important demand.

Good Roads, Quality Education, Good health and secure life is considered as backbone of development of nation. Therefore education sector is required to be improved by construction of ~~class~~ classrooms at middle school FawA. Electric network and water pipeline network needs to be improved. major threat to human life is due to the uncontrolled water in escape nallah. there must be a warning ~~by~~ sounds/sirens before opening the gate of power Canal towards escape Nallah and protection bunds along b/s of escape Nallah.

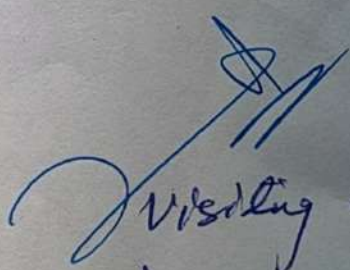
