1. Major Complaints brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer B2V4 of Panchayat Halqa Lastiyal of Block Kalaroos.

1. The newly constructed PMGSY road "Madmadow to Lastiyal" has not benefited the population of village Listayal because of the fact, that a small portion of about 300 Meters have not constructed by the executing agency, which will connected this road with the habitation. The spot verification was conducted by the Visiting Officer and complaint was found genuine, hence the complaint deserves consideration.
2. That, the inner link roads, leading towards Tourist Spot "Satbaran Caves", Panchayat Bown and Middle School Lastiyal are in dilapidated condition and needs improvement for convince of the masses in general and tourists in particular.
3. The, the drinking water supplied to some habitations of the village is of poor quality being directly supplied from irrigation Khul of the village. The matter needs immediate intervention of the authorities to save the people from infections and diseases.

III. Overall assessment of the visit and suggestions of the Visiting Officer B2V4 of Panchayat Halqa Lastiyal of Block Kalaroos.

Generally the people residing in Panchayat Halqa Lastiyal Block Kalaroos, are very poor and are unaware of various welfare schemes of the government, hence special awareness programmes and IEC campaign should be organised by the different departments in Panchayat Halqa Lastiyal, to enable eligible people, to get benefits under various relevant schemes of the government.

The Village is having high tourism potential because of "Satbaran Caves" which are situated in Panchayat Halqa Lastiyal, however necessary infrastructure is required in this behalf and special attention of the authorities of LBDDA is invited on the matter. The people should be encouraged for creating facilities of "Home Stays" for guests and tourists who want to visit "Satbaran Caves."

The inner link roads, leading towards Tourist Spot "Satbaran Caves", Panchayat Bown and Middle School Lastiyal are in dilapidated condition and needs improvement for convince of the masses in general and tourists in particular.

The drinking water supplied to some habitations of the village is of poor quality being directly supplied from irrigation Khul of the village. The matter needs immediate intervention of the authorities to save the people from infections and diseases.
