



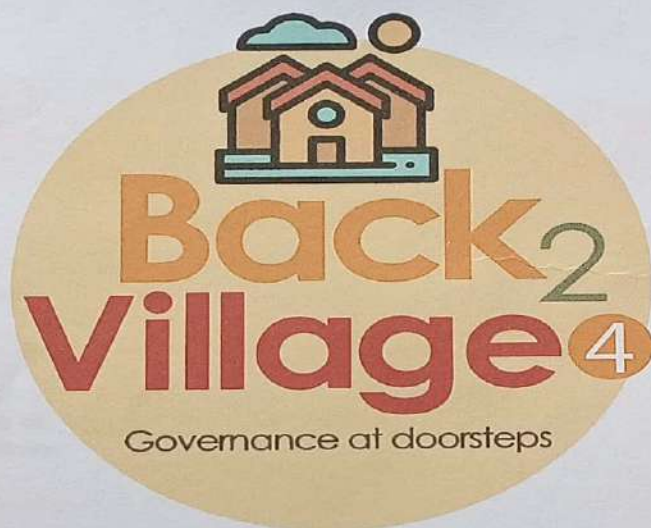

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

However, the undersigned during the visit to schools / AWS near Nallas saw a patch of land which could be utilized for construction of Marriage Hall. This suggestion was highly appreciated and therefore needs consideration.
