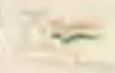

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. 2. He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
6. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.

1. The visit to PH-Dangerpora Under B2V4 has been a great experience. The ~~people~~ general public of the Panchayat Halva, Line departments, Frontline workers, PRIs were very enthusiastic for the said program.

2. As a visiting officer I could understand that the major issue of the concerned Panchayat Hatqa is Non-availability of Revenue Record which as per the Villagers and Revenue officials has been Seized by the Vigilance dept. and has not been returned back due to which the PH-Dangarpura faces tremendous hardships. I strongly suggest that the Revenue Records should be returned back so that they shall take benefit of all Govt. Schemes/Programs.

2. Secondly the Lack of drinking water is another big problem in the PH-Dangarpura. which needs immediate redressal.

3. Further the Awareness Programs regarding Govt. Programs/Schemes should be regularly carried out in the PH-Dangarpura so that the people can reap the benefits of all programs/schemes.

As a visiting officer of the PH-Dangarpura I strongly suggest that the genuine demands of PH-Dangarpura are given due consideration so that the very purpose of B2V4 Program is achieved.
