





- Throughout the present B.V.s and previous back to village programmes, the main pressing demand by the public has been to operationalise the Hospital on priority basis as it is lying inoperative since 2008. Consequently it causes a lot of hardships for the public as they have to travel long distance to reach Tangmarg hospital. Due to this many precious lives have been lost. It is therefore impressed upon the concerned govt. function to immediately make this hospital fully functional on priority basis.
 - All Back to village programmes have called for upgrading the present high school Chandil-Mangar to Hr Sec level which is justified given the area is hilly and the children have to travel about 8 to 10 km from various Jaraway areas to reach Chandilora Hr Sec
 - Animal husbandry unit should be provided as the area is rich in livestock
 - Handicraft, toy making and other skill oriented units shall be started to generate the employment for the local youth.
- Overall the B.V.s programme was a success compared to previous B.S.V. programmes as the community was very satisfied with the work of various govt departments at times. On the basis of this, the overall rating of govt functioning can be given as 07/10.
