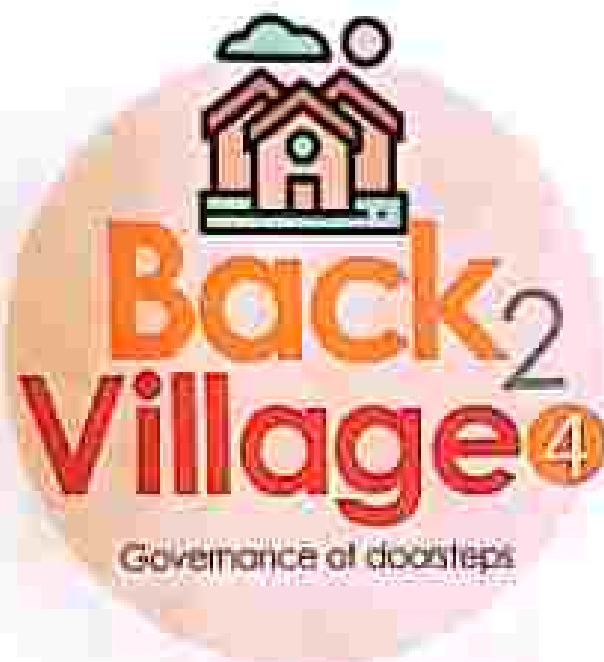

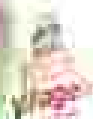

- Throughout the present B.Vs and previous back to village programmes, the main pressing demand by the public has been to operationalise the hospital on priority basis as it is lying inoperative since 2008. Consequently it causes a lot of hardships for the public as they have to travel long distance to reach Tangmay hospital. Due to this many precious lives have been lost. It is therefore impressed upon the concerned govt. quarters to immediately make this hospital fully functional on priority basis.
- All Back to village programmes have called for upgrading the present high school Chandil-Nangon to H.S. level which is justified given the area is hilly and the children have to travel about 8 to 10 km from various Jaramy area to reach Chandilora H.S.
- Animal husbandary unit should be provided as the area is rich in livestock.
- Handicraft, bag making and other skill oriented units shall be started to generate the employment for the local youth.
