GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
2. He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
6. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.

Dear Sir/Ma'am,

My name is Poonam Singh, W/o Ranbhir Singh, currently posted at GPS Lallesian, District Reasi. I joined the Department of Education (DoE), Jammu & Kashmir, as a RET Teacher in 2004, and after a few years, I was regularized in 2009. In the meanwhile, I got married in 2005. As a part of our tradition, a daughter has to settle with her husband, so I had to shift from Reasi District to Udhampur District.

I have taught and trained the children of the marginalized and oppressed sections of society for the last eighteen years. I have to travel for more than seventy kilometres and then walk on foot for six kilometres in an isolated dense forest full of wild animals, reptiles, trenches and cliffs. I have risked my life several times by passing through the tributary of the Chenab River during the rainy seasons. I had gone through two horrible accidents while passing through such difficult terrain. Physically and mentally, I am drained. I have knocked on every door for the deliverance of Justice but received nothing in return.

In the past eighteen years, I have gone through horrible experiences that have shaped my thoughts and choices about my profession as a female teacher and gender justice. From the beginning, I have requested the successive CEOs, ZEOs, Directors and other staff officials for the Inter-District Transfer, i.e. from Reasi to Udhampur but ended up getting temporary 'attachments' from one school to another instead. Finally, I tried doing it through the mechanism of Mutual Transfer, but it's been five months, and I haven't received any response from the respective department. My husband is an Army personnel and has less time to visit us (me, my daughter and a son). I have to take care of the children and family chores. It becomes difficult for a mother of two to find a balance between personal and private spheres. As a result, I feel alienated and detached from both spheres.

I requested the present CEO, Reasi, to temporarily attach me to a school in Sidha, Katkayal (Udhampur District), but they are suggesting I go to the same place, which is unsafe for a female teacher. A male teacher would be the best option in this area, but I am being forced to go to the same place for eighteen years. An inter-district transfer is a distant dream, so I tried through mutual transfer, but as of now, I am not even entitled to get an attachment to a school which falls under the Udhampur district.

I have mailed several higher authorities regarding my mutual transfer order with Neelam Devi, but I haven't received any response from them. Since 9th June 2022, my file has been lying in the Secretariat (Jammu) and said authorities say that the education department can only do your work once the Secretariat shifts to Jammu. I have been facing this delay in Justice for the last several years now. The maxim of 'justice delayed is justice denied' applies in my case very well. I would like you to find some amicable solution to the problem.

I request you look into the matter and resolve it as soon as possible. I will be thankful to you for this kind act.
