ICDS dept. is just in count, otherwise worst performance is observed in connection to infrastructure, accommodation, attendance of children and maintenance of record in all OS AWCs in the Panchayat. Reply:- III - Assessment

The Panchayat is located at the corner of dist. Seems to be somewhat over and it has been overlooked with respect to provision of basic amenities and accompanying. Major issues assessed during visit in the Panchayat by uprd, are reflected on work.

I. Road Connectivity:- Still not available although got sanctioned and execution of work is under process but due to forest dept. issue, work has been temporarily stopped, is a current obstacle.

II. Non-availability of Health care centres:- Keeping in view hard and worst topography of the Panchayat wherein 1818 souls exist, no health care centre found located/sanctioned. The public made demand since long back but over time for the reason best known to concerned dept. There is acute need to open atleast medical Aid centre immediately to cater the burning issue in the Panchayat.

III. Non-availability of Net work facility:- Tower for networking is duly required in the Panchayat as no facility is available as myself (V.O) failed to submit on-line data/information/Policy of Geo Tag photos etc due to lack of facility.

IV. Schooling facilities for Higher classes:- As the entire Panchayat where 1818 souls exist and no High School facility is available. The students used to walk atleast 7-8 km daily on foot to reach HSS Lhai-A is quite noticeable for which I have personally assessed. So, HPS Thana is eligible in all respects for its up-gradation to the level of High School to fulfil the basic need of children.

V. Drinking water facilities:- For storage of water, Sinterex Pankas for poor families is required and demand has been projected in Gram Sabha also.

GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER

I	Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer: <i>The basic facilities mentioned at SNo II have been projected time and again for the betterment of Panchayat but still not fulfilled.</i>
