It was my first visit as a visiting officer. I started my visit on 30th Oct. during which I interacted with general public and conducted an open debate with all stakeholders. The people were happy but at the same time they complained of delay to complete some projects. Some of them raised main issues such as roads, electricity problems, drinking water and so on. Some raised their personal issues which were answered by the on line officials on spot.

Meetings with senior citizens and small children (BS) were very interesting and praise worthy. Senior citizens shared their views and experiences with us. They stressed to make these programmes a success through accountability and transparency. Children were very happy and shared their views with us.

We also visited Anganwadi centres and talked to workers, noted down their grievances and problems, among them was pending of their honorarium, pending cases of Marriage Assistance for poor girls. The team talked to ASHA workers and enquired of many schemes for pregnant ladies and other programmes active in their Panchayat.

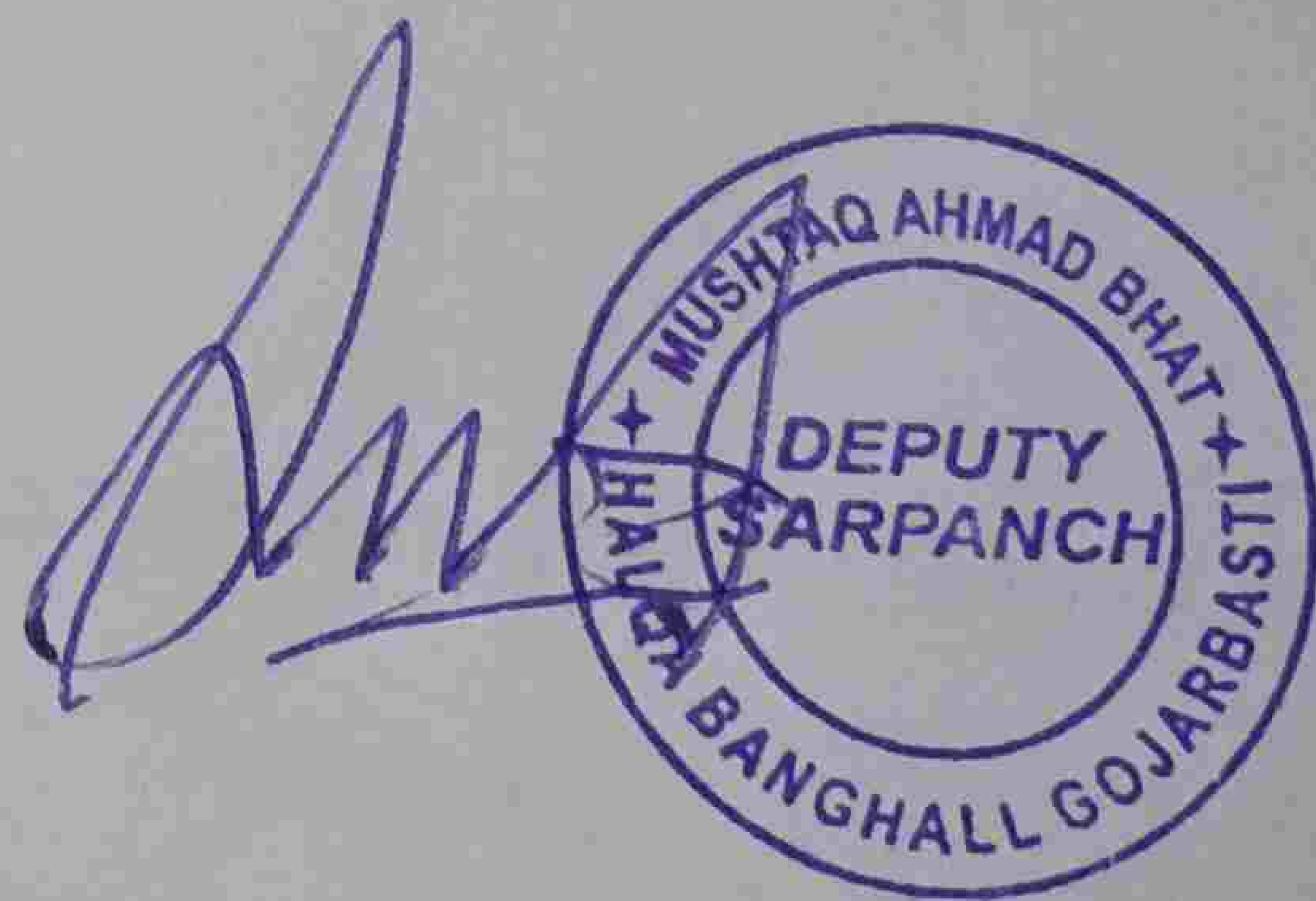
On 2nd day of visit social audit of some works was done along with Panchayat body. Overall physical status of these works was satisfactory. Among these, were, installation of Transformers, Tile lanes and Protection Bunds. Educational institute is working very well, although there are some issues such as non-availability of Kitchen Shed, Boundary wall & play ground. People also demanded some offices such as Sheep Husbandary unit, Bank faculty, Play ground for village youths, agricultural office, widening and repairing of roads, extension of line roads and maintenance of electric poles and wires.

Overall visit was healthy and satisfactory with bits of sweetness and bitterness.
